Dear Parishioners,

*“He instructed them to take nothing for the journey

This part from today’s Gospel brought back many memories of my recent trip on the El Camino de Santiago (The Way of St. James). I went on this pilgrimage with my brother seminarians, Fr. Mike Romano, and Fr. Adam Cichoski. What struck me in this passage was that St. James was present during this event, and he remembered to do as Christ instructed by preaching throughout Spain. Eventually, he died in the Holy Land but two men brought his remains back to Spain in order for people to venerate him. This journey isn’t easy, believe me. There is a lot of studying, scheduling, meetings, preparing, and praying. I honestly believe that if I didn’t have my “walking stick” I wouldn’t be able to make it through the first week. My “walking stick” was my rock of faith. It was my shield against the temptations. It was my strength through difficult times. It was Jesus Christ who gave me the graces needed for the journey I am partaking in. He was my walking stick through prayer and the people I encountered. He was the one that guided me through this past year, and he is the one who will guide me in the years to come.

I pray that everyone reading this will be able to find, or hopefully even found, the journey Christ is leading them to take. It is extremely important. Why? Because it helps build up the Kingdom of God on earth and helps us fall in love more and more with the one who loved us before we were born—the Lord our God.

The Catholic Strong Commitment Form Envelopes located in the pews, at the Welcome Center, and at other locations around the church are for our visitors who would like to contribute to our Capital Campaign, by committing to a 5 year plan or a one time donation. **All year-round, registered Parishioners will receive a specific mailing or visit in order to ascertain your commitment to your parish through the Catholic Strong campaign.**

Frequently Asked Questions

Are gifts to the campaign tax deductible?

Yes. Pledge payments are tax deductible to the fullest extent of the law.

Are donors able to pay pledges using a credit card, debit card, or through automatic withdrawal from a checking or savings account?

Yes. A donor may fulfill a pledge using a credit card, debit card, or automatic withdrawal from a checking or savings account. Donors simply provide their account information and their authorization on their personalized pledge card.

Why are donors asked to complete a pledge card?

Pledge cards aid in appropriately recording and acknowledging commitments, and in providing donors with a reminder of subsequent payments according to the schedule they request. Donors are asked to sign the pledge card, indicating that they have authorized the terms of the gift indicated on the card. *A pledge card is not a legally binding document.*

Can donors make gifts of stock or other non-cash gifts?

The campaign accepts gifts of stock and other non-liquid assets, including real estate. Donors wishing to make a gift of stock should follow the stock transfer instructions included in each solicitation packet. Donors wishing to make non-cash gifts should speak with their pastor/pastoral administrator or contact the Diocese of Camden regarding our gift acceptance policy.

Donors who are considering a gift from a donor advised fund, or those considering an estate gift, should contact Jim Lanahan, Director of Development at the Diocese of Camden, by calling 856.583.6125.

Who should donors make checks payable to?

All contributions should be made payable to *Catholic Strong*.

How are the campaign expenses currently being paid?

The costs of the campaign are being paid from the diocesan share of the funds collected.
