Dear Parishioners,

It is hard to believe that I am writing my farewell bulletin article. While I am writing this, I am questioning where the time has gone! It feels just like yesterday that I arrived to speak on Good Shepherd Sunday, which coincided with the parish's First Communion.

One of the most important qualities that the seminary faculty tries to instill in men immersed in priestly formation, is the importance of reflection. While at the seminary reflecting on your studies, your pastoral assignments, your relationships with brother seminarians, and of course on your relationship with God. When reflecting and praying over these past two months at Notre Dame de la Mer, I have seen the countless blessings God has bestowed upon me through every single one of you. While sitting in the classrooms up at the seminary is extremely important, having a parish assignment in the summer is all the more important. Bishop Sullivan and the faculty at Saint Joseph's Seminary have entrusted my formation over these past two months to the priests and parishioners of Notre Dame de la Mer. For a priest is not a priest for himself, but rather a priest for the people! My time here in Wildwood has helped me to understand to the fullest extent what Pope Francis meant when he told priests, "to be shepherds with the smell of sheep." Each of the priests here at the parish, especially Father Wallace, have been great examples of the Holy Father's pastoral call of smelling like the sheep. Which I guess in Wildwood means the smell of the fresh salt air! Sorry – I had to throw one joke in this article!

I am in debt to Bishop Sullivan for sending me to a parish with great priests, religious, parish staff, schools, and parishioners. Please allow me to thank everyone on the island for welcoming with open arms to this beautiful and dedicated parish family! As many of you know, I am embarking on a Pilgrimage known as the "Camino de Santiago" (The Way of Saint James) starting this week. Please be assured of my prayers for every single one of you while on my 200 Mile walk and most especially my prayers for you at the tomb of Saint James where my pilgrimage will end. Know that this will not be my final farewell because I will be back August 14th for the Wedding of the Sea vigil mass for the Assumption at Saint Ann's Church. What a great day that will be for our parish family, because one of your own parishioners Tom Piro will process up the main isle of Saint Ann's in cassock and surplice for the first time with all the seminarians of the Diocese.
