

From the desk of Jonathan Delgado, Director of Music and Liturgy

Dear Parishioner,

In today's gospel when the followers of Jesus ask him to show them how to pray, Jesus starts with how to address God, simply 'father.' It is familial, simple and unpretentious. What then follows is much of what we now call 'the Lord's prayer' or the 'Our Father.' What is particularly interesting in Luke's version is the disciples seem prompted to ask Jesus how to pray after witnessing Jesus engaged in prayer first. They want something of what Jesus has. They are witnessing the deep relationship between Jesus and God and they want to be part of it – not simply to 'look on.' Jesus effectively says, you have what I have by talking to God as a loving parent, because that is what God is. There are many images that we have in attempting to capture the infinite nature of God. However, our readings remind us that the most fundamental approach we should have to God is based on God as a loving parent.

Today marks the middle of ordinary time, which means there are only five months until Christmas, sorry! We certainly have been in and continue to be in full summer mode here on the Island as well as in our parish here at Notre Dame de la Mer. It is a blessing to see so many faithful attending weekly and weekend Masses, parishioners and visitors alike. I am most touched by the amount of summer visitors who have volunteered their time while here to serve in one of many ministries here in our parish, everyone's commitment to serve has aided in providing us with reverent, holy and the most beautiful liturgies. Thank you all!

Please mark your calendars for the Feast of the Assumption Vigil Mass and traditional Wedding of the Sea. We will join together in celebration on August 14th for 4:30PM Mass at St. Ann Church, with preludes from our choir and orchestra beginning at 4:00PM, which will be celebrated by Bishop Joseph Williams. All of our seminarians will be joining us on this great feast for our Lady as well.

As we continue through this most beautiful, alive time of year here, let us continue to spread our love, our ministry and our call to serve to all in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ!

Readings of the Week

Reading I: Genesis 18:20-32

Will you sweep away the innocent with the guilty?

- The reading from Genesis is a classic example of prayer in the Old Testament.
- It is from the Yahwist tradition of the Pentateuch and was written around the tenth century B.C.
- In the Yahwist tradition God was very close to humans and displayed human traits.

Reading II: Colossians 2:12-14

God made you alive with Christ for he has forgiven all

- The reading from the Letter to the Colossians attempts to explain why Christians can pray with such confidence.
- Baptism has united Christians with Christ in his death as well as his resurrection power.
- Christ has won our friendship with God.

Gospel : Luke 11:1-13

Hallowed be your name.

- The passage from the Gospel of Luke is a collection of Jesus' reflections on prayer.
- The first section (verses 1-4) is the Lucan version of the Lord's Prayer.
- The version in Luke is shorter than the one in Matthew's Gospel.

Family Reflection Corner

Theme: The Lord's Prayer is a map for life.

Breaking Open the Word

Suggested text for faith sharing: Today's Gospel

Step One: Listen to the Word

As you hear this reading, what words or phrases strike you? What in this reading touches your heart? What lingers in your memory?

Step Two: Look into Your Life

Question for Children: Prayer is talking with God and listening to God in our hearts. Where do you talk to God and how do you listen to what God says to you?

Question for Youth: Jesus teaches us how important it is to pray. How do you ask God for what you need? How do you listen for his response?

Question for Adults: Jesus teaches us how to pray. When this past week did you take the time to pray, to talk to and listen to God?





SCHOOL YEAR Family Catechesis:

Classes will be held one Sunday a month. Parents are to join the children at class and do assignments at home as a family. At WCA 9 - 10:10 a.m

SUMMER INTENSIVE: Classes are held daily from 8:30 a.m. to noon, for two weeks during the summer.
