## *From the Desk of Tom Piro - Seminarian*

Dear Parishioner,

Today is my last Sunday at St. Joseph parish in Sea Isle City! It is crazy to think that my summer assignment is coming to an end, and a new semester will be starting in the coming weeks. I am deeply grateful to Bishop Sullivan for assigning me to St. Joseph's for two summers. After today, I will be back at Notre Dame De La Mer for daily Mass and Sunday Mass when I am home from the seminary. I also look forward to stopping in some classrooms during this last week of summer intensive.

During one of my Wednesday reflections in Sea Isle, I mentioned how Jesus' parables and teachings are not always easy to follow. Sometimes, we hear the gospel for the day, and we shake our heads and say, "I don't know about this one, Lord." Today's gospel is certainly one of them! Naturally, we store up our savings and make sure we have enough food, water, and shelter. Sometimes, we may think we need to save more, which is wise in case of emergency, but at what point does our wisdom become greed and selfishness? Will we be like the rich man, a fool? The gospel is not supposed to be easy. It is a call and challenge to be Christian, a challenge to be Christ-like.

We can be greedy about our money, our time, and our talents. We may know someone needs help, but we refuse to offer ourselves in service. In our own parish, we have several different ministries that could use some help. If you bring your children to Mass, why not ask them if they would be interested in becoming an altar server? If you know you have a skill at comforting others, consider joining the bereavement ministry. If you have a talent for designing and decorating (which I certainly do not have!), consider reaching out to help decorate the church for the different liturgical seasons and feasts. A great opportunity for this could be the Wedding of the Sea in two weeks. We need some people to carry the banners in the procession to the ocean.

I look forward to being back in Wildwood, and I ask you to please continue to pray for me and my other seminarians. Please be assured of my daily prayers for you.

## Readings of the Week

### Reading I: [Ecclesiastes 1:2, 2:21-23](#)

*What do all her/his labors profit a person?*

- Today's first reading was written by a sage, or philosopher, who had spent much time reflecting on human life.
- The author observes that one pervasive human vanity is the inability to enjoy those things we earn.
- The reading from Ecclesiastes stresses that we have only the present moment—and that moment is a gift from God.

### Reading II: [Colossians 3:1-5, 9-11](#)

*Seek the things that are of Christ.*

- The Letter of Paul to the Colossians warns against excessive attachment to material possessions.
- These sins which pertain to worldly life were part of the community's everyday life before they were Christian.
- Now they have put on Christ, the new Adam.

### Gospel: [Luke 12:13-21](#)

*What is really important to you?*

- In the Gospel of Luke, the question of possessions is treated often.
- In today's Gospel, Jesus tells a parable about a wealthy fool who thought possessions guaranteed life.
- He is a fool because in the midst of his good fortune he has lost the sense of what is truly important.

### Weekly Readings Reflection

Choose one of the following activities as a way to further reflect on the Sunday readings.

- Create a "Household Values" statement. Discuss the family's priorities and values. Identify values that are most important to the household and write them down. Are the family members' priorities in line with God's teaching or do they need some adjusting? Keep the written statement in your home as a reminder for the family of what is really important in life.
- Reflect on how you can use your possessions, money and gifts in the service of God and neighbor. What organizations in your community are helping those in need? Get involved with this group!

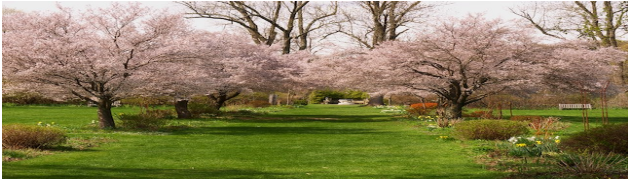

## What Is the Feast of the Assumption?

Today, Catholics and many other Christians celebrate the feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This significant feast day recalls the spiritual and physical departure of the mother of Jesus Christ from the earth, when both her soul and her body were taken into the presence of God.

Venerable Pope Pius XII confirmed this belief about the Virgin Mary as the perennial teaching of the Church when he defined it formally as a dogma of Catholic faith in 1950, invoking papal infallibility to proclaim, "that the Immaculate Mother of God, the ever-Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory."

His Apostolic Constitution "Munificentissimus Deus" (Most Bountiful God), which defined the dogma, contained the Pontiff's accounts of many longstanding traditions by which the Church has celebrated the Assumption throughout its history.

The constitution also cited testimonies from the early Church fathers on the subject, and described the history of theological reflection on many Biblical passages which are seen as indicating that Mary was assumed into heaven following her death.

Although the bodily assumption of Mary is not explicitly recorded in Scripture, Catholic tradition identifies her with the "woman clothed with the sun" who is described in the 12th chapter of the Book of Revelation.

The passage calls that woman's appearance "a great sign" which "appeared in heaven," indicating that she is the mother of the Jewish Messiah and has "the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars." Accordingly, Catholic iconography of the Western tradition often depicts the Virgin Mary's assumption into heaven in this manner.

Eastern Christians have also traditionally held Mary's assumption into heaven as an essential component of their faith. Pius XII cited several early Byzantine liturgical texts, as well as the eighth-century Arab Christian theologian St. John of Damascus, in his own authoritative definition of her assumption.

"It was fitting," St. John of Damascus wrote in a sermon on the assumption, "that she, who had kept her virginity intact in childbirth, should keep her own body free from all corruption even after death," and "that she, who had carried the creator as a child at her breast, should dwell in the divine tabernacles."

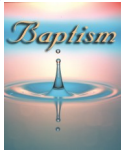

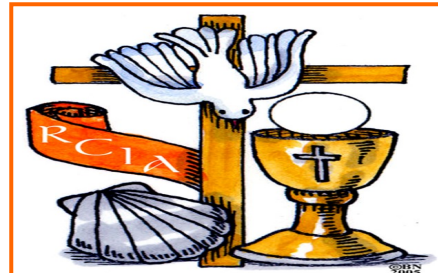

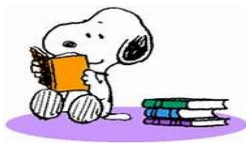
### Parish Religious Education Program
