Saint of the Week

St. Aloysius Gonzaga 1568-1591

Aloysius was the oldest son and heir of the Marquis Ferrante of Castiglione who was in the service of Philip II of Spain. His father wished to see Aloysius become a military officer, but Aloysius had another idea in mind. At about the age of seven, Aloysius had a spiritual awakening and began his day with regular prayers, including the Office of Mary and the Psalms. At nine, he was sent to Florence to be educated. By the time he was eleven, Aloysius was teaching the catechism to poor children and fasting three days a week as well as practicing other austerities. After reading a book about the Jesuits' experiences in the missions of India, Aloysius decided to enter the Society of Jesus. His father strongly objected to his decision and enlisted the aid of eminent churchmen and noblemen to persuade Aloysius to pursue a more "normal" career. After a four-year struggle, his father relented and Aloysius joined the Jesuits in Rome in 1585. During his studies at the Jesuit seminary in Milan, Aloysius undertook different spiritual practices. Under his spiritual advisor, St. Robert Bellermino, he was obliged to eat more than he previously had, to take exercise with his fellow seminarians, and to pray only at the appointed times. Because of his frail health, Aloysius was called to Rome and took his vows there in 1587. Several years later, a plague struck Rome. The Jesuits, in response, opened a hospital to care for the victims. Together with the other Jesuits, Aloysius performed personal services for the patients, nursing them, washing them and making their beds. Aloysius, already in frail health, caught the affliction himself. He became so weak that he could scarcely get up from his bed, yet he continued his daily devotions. Within three months, after receiving the last rites from St. Robert Bellermino, Aloysius Gonzaga died at the age of 23 on June 21, 1591. Aloysius Gonzaga was canonized in 1726. He was declared protector of young students by Pope Benedict XIII, and patron of Catholic youth by Pope Pius XI. We honor this saint on June 21 by a memorial.

Reflections on the Readings

Reading I: Ecclesiastes 1:2, 2:21-23

What do all her/his labors profit a person?

- ◆ Today's first reading was written by a sage or philosopher who had spent much time reflecting on human life
- ◆ The author observes that one pervasive human vanity is the inability to enjoy those things we earn
- ◆ The reading stresses that we have only the present moment—and that moment is a gift from God

Reading II: Colossians 3:1-5, 9-11

Seek the things that are of Christ

- ◆ Today's second reading warns against excessive attachment to material possessions
- ◆ Sins which pertain to worldly life were part of the community's everyday life before they were Christian
- ◆ Now they have put on Christ who is the new Adam

Gospel: Luke 12:13-21

What is really important to you?

- ◆ In the Gospel, Jesus tells a parable about a wealthy fool who thought possessions guaranteed life
- ◆ He is a fool because in the midst of his good fortune he has lost the sense of what is truly important

Family Guide to Lectio Divina

Gospel: Luke 12:13-21

Theme: Faith helps us set Godly priorities

STEP 1: Listen to today's Gospel

- ◆ What words or phrases strike you?
- ◆ What in this Gospel touches your heart?

STEP 2: Look into your life

Question for Children:

- ◆ What is the most important thing in your life?

Questions for Youth: It is easy to get self-centered and greedy.

- ◆ What do you have in your life that is unnecessary?
- ◆ In your life, what keeps you close to God?
- ◆ What distracts you from your relationship with God?

SCHOOL YEAR Family Catechesis:

Classes will be held one Sunday a month.
Parents are to join the children at class and
do assignments at home as a family.
At WCA 9:00AM to 10:10AM

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION: Preparation to receive First Eucharist, and/or Confirmation requires a two-year commitment to PREP classes as well as classes especially designed to strengthen the understanding of the sacraments. Attendance at Retreats, Service Projects and Parent meetings is also required.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL STUDENTS: All students are required to do six (6) Faith-Filled Events, outside the normal classroom setting, throughout the year. This is to help the child understand that faith happens everyday all around you. Not just in class or mass.
