The Transfiguration of the Lord

Dear Parishioner,

As we celebrate the Transfiguration of the Lord this weekend we contemplate through the readings, prayers, homilies and song the great mystery of life after death. Jesus gives his closest confidants a glimpse into eternity as he is transfigured before their very eyes. The Prophet Daniel sets the stage as he shares his mystical experience of the Beatific Vision. God enthroned amid the hosts of heaven and One like a Son of Man who receives “dominion, glory and kingship.” His reign is eternal and all the people of the earth who serve Him shall share in his Kingdom for all eternity.

Next Monday, August 14th at 4:30pm at St. Ann Church, Bishop Sullivan and all the seminarians from our diocese will celebrate the feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This Mass celebrates our Patronal Feast Day and is followed by the procession to the ocean for the formal Wedding of the Sea devotion. This feast of the Assumption coincides with the theme found in our liturgies this weekend as Mary is the first fruit of the redemptive actions of Jesus on behalf of all humanity. Her being taken up to heaven in glory at the end of her earthly life signals what is in store for all who place our hope and trust in our loving Savior.

Both our second reading and Gospel bring to mind the words of God the Father at the moment of Jesus’ Transfiguration “This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him.” Listening to the Word of God made flesh and acting on His Word, will bring us like Mary, to the shores of eternity. Opening our hearts and minds to the saving grace afforded us at baptism will lead to our own ultimate transfiguration and entrance into eternity.

I hope you will make every effort to join us for the liturgy at 4:30pm on Monday, August 14th. It is always such a beautiful and meaningful gathering for our parish and we are happy and honored to have Bishop Sullivan as main celebrant and all the seminarians to help celebrate our patronal feast day.

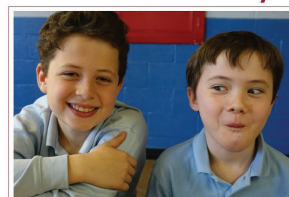

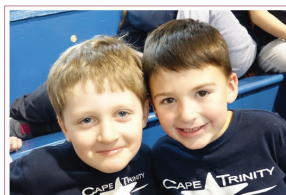

You are cordially invited to celebrate the Wedding of the Sea on August 14, 2017. Celebration will begin at St. Ann's Church, 2900 Atlantic Ave. Starting at 4:00 pm there will be musical selections performed by the NDDL M Music Ministry and accompanying orchestra. The vigil mass celebrating the Assumption of Mary into heaven follows at 4:30 pm. Immediately following mass, the procession to the ocean will begin. Once at the water's edge, Wildwood lifeguards will take the bishop into the tide where he will bless the ocean by throwing a ring of flowers. A tradition started in Venice, Italy in the 1400's. A gold ring would be tossed into the ocean 'Marrying' it to the land. This symbolic gesture shows the significance the ocean has on the land in all Shore towns. A union so very important then as it is today. All are welcome to celebrate!!
