

Transfiguration of Our Lord

"...then from the cloud came a voice that said, 'This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him.'" -
MATTHEW 17:5

TRANSFIGURATION OF OUR LORD

The Feast of the Transfiguration commemorates the moment Jesus took Peter, James, and John to the top of Mount Tabor and manifested himself as the Son of God. It may be found in the Synoptic Gospels (Matthew, Mark, and Luke). This moment is crucial since it follows the Confession of St. Peter (“who do people say that I am?” “You are the Christ”) and Christ confirms his confession. Christ manifests himself with Moses and Elijah each representing the Law (Torah) and the prophets respectively.

Christ is the fulfillment of all that has come before him (the Law and the prophets). Once he fulfills the covenant the Lord has made through his death and resurrection, he shows the three apostles how glorious his resurrected body will be. The evangelists write: his “face shone like the sun, and his garments became white as light” (Matthew 17:2), “his garments became glistening, intensely white, as no fuller on earth could bleach them” (Mark 9:3), “the appearance of his countenance was altered, and his raiment became dazzling white” (Luke 9:29). Recall how in the resurrection accounts, his disciples do not recognize him. The humanity of Jesus Christ has been transformed or transfigured to show the glory and splendor of God.

The Transfiguration is celebrated every year on August 6 and reminds us of our own transfiguration. Indeed, we are not transfigured as Jesus was on the mountain, but at our baptisms, God the Father declared, “this is my beloved son” or “this is my beloved daughter.” Our souls have been transformed through the death and resurrection of Christ by the power of the Holy Spirit. We bear the mark of Christian in our souls, which can never be taken away from us.

As we continue to live our lives as Christians, we profess our faith at every Sunday Mass and state we believe in the resurrection of the dead towards the end of the creed. This does not affirm our faith in the Resurrection of Christ (that was done earlier in the creed), but rather our belief in the resurrection of all the dead! Just as Christ rose from the grave, so too will we rise from the grave. Just as Christ received a glorified body, so too will we receive a glorified body. We will be truly united to our transfigured bodies! In our preface for the day, we pray:

For he revealed his glory in the presence of chosen witnesses and filled with the greatest splendor that bodily form which he shares with all humanity that the scandal of the cross might be removed from the hearts of his disciples and that he might show how in the Body of the whole Church is to be fulfilled what's so wonderfully shown forth first in its head

Choose one of the following activities as a way to further reflect on the Sunday readings.

- In the Gospel, God's voice comes from a cloud saying, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him" (Matthew 17:5). Invite family members to share how they listen to Jesus.
- Place a cross near the entrance of your home. Talk together about how this symbol serves as a reminder to listen to Jesus and allow him to transform your life. As family members enter and leave your home, you will be reminded to love God and others as Jesus did.
- With the more relaxed schedule of summer, this is a perfect time to invite another person or family to join your family at Mass or another parish event. Talk together about whom you might invite. If appropriate, invite the person or family to Mass followed by breakfast or lunch together.




