



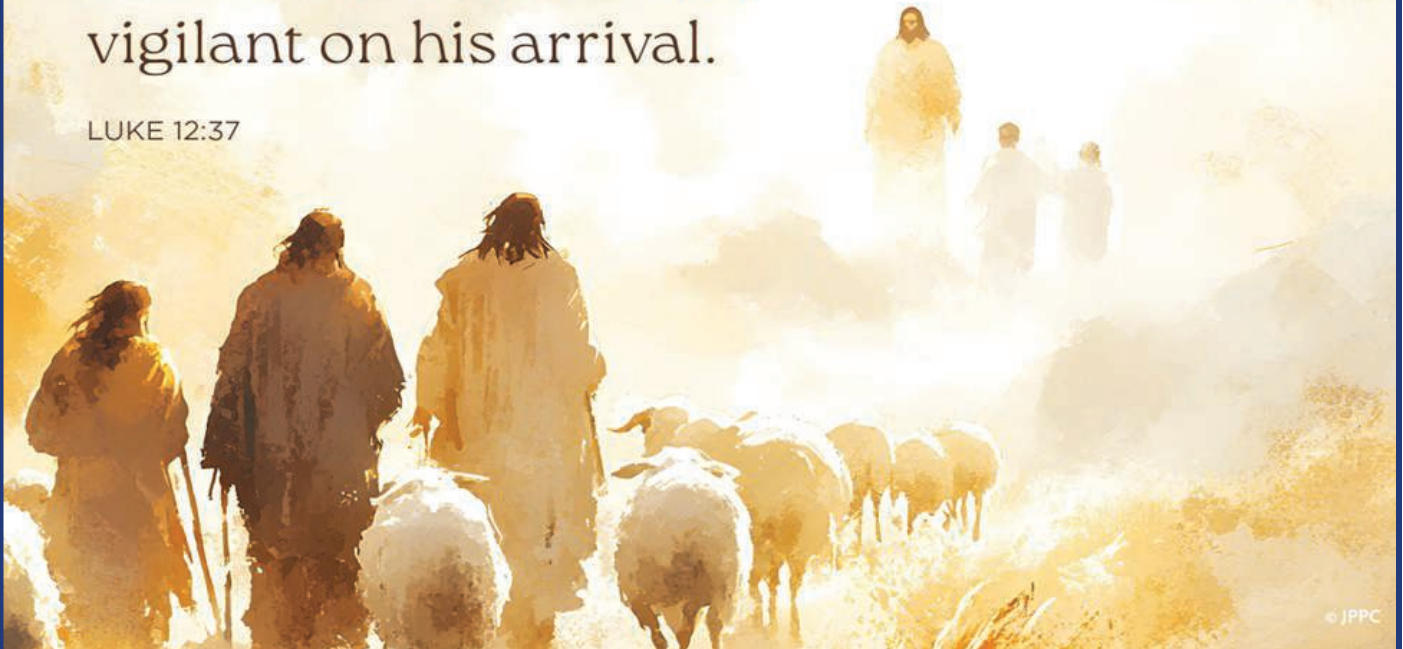

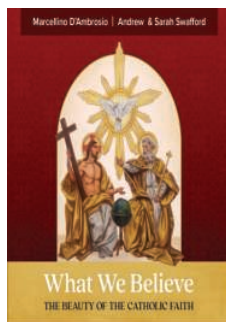

### Saint of the Week

#### St. Monica

332-387

Monica was born in Tagaste, North Africa and raised a Christian by her parents. When she was old enough to marry, her parents arranged a marriage with Patricius, a pagan who was also from Tagaste. During her marriage she had to deal with her husband's raging temper and inclination to dissoluteness and with her quarrelsome mother-in-law who lived with them. Monica persisted in prayer for both her husband and his mother and they eventually both converted to Christianity. Monica and Patricius had three children, the oldest of whom became Saint Augustine and was declared a Doctor of the Church. Augustine showed much promise from his earliest days and his parents gave him the best education possible. But though he became a catechumen at an early age, Augustine drifted away from Christianity during his school years. About two years after the death of her husband, Monica was crushed to learn that Augustine was living a life of immorality and was adhering to the Manichaen heresy. When Augustine returned to Tagaste to teach, Monica at first refused to let him live with her but a vision caused her to relent when the voice of the radiant figure she saw in her vision told her to dry her tears and said, "*Your son is with you.*" When Monica told Augustine of the vision, he responded that they could well be together if she would give up her faith. Monica's response was "*He did not say that I was with you; he said that you were with me.*" Augustine later wrote that he regarded this as a watershed moment in his life though it was still years before his conversion. Monica continued to pray and fast for her son's spiritual health. She sought help from her priests and bishop to convince Augustine of his error but they recognized that they would have no effect on him in his then state of mind. Her bishop told her, "*Go now, I beg of you; it is not possible that a son of so many tears should perish.*" Monica followed after Augustine when he moved to Rome to teach when he was twenty-nine. But by the time Monica reached Rome, her son had moved on to Milan. There, Augustine fell under the influence of the bishop, Saint Ambrose. When Monica eventually arrived in Milan after an arduous journey, Augustine announced to her that he no longer believed in the Manichaen heresy. As she rejoiced over that good news, he reminded her that he was not yet a Christian. She responded that he would be before she died. In Milan, Monica was a leader of a group of devout, prayerful women. Monica's prayers for Augustine were finally answered when, after years of discussion and instruction with Saint Ambrose, he was baptized at the Easter Vigil in 387. Augustine then made plans to return to North Africa with his mother, but Monica knew that she would not return there. She told Augustine, "*Son, nothing in this world now affords me delight; all my hopes for this world have been fulfilled. All I wished to live for was that I might see you a Catholic and a child of heaven. God has granted me more than this.*" A few days later, Monica became ill and shortly after that, died. Saint Monica is the patron of mothers, wives, alcoholics and those seeking perseverance in prayer. A memorial honors her on August 27.

#### **SCHOOL YEAR Family Catechesis:**

Classes will be held one Sunday a month.

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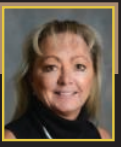
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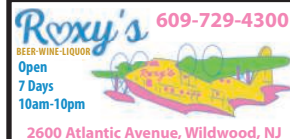
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
