

# Message From Fr. Yvans Jazon, Parochial Vicar



Dear Parishioners,

Sometimes we need to hear straight talk about important truths, such as: "God is good all the time and all the time God is good". These simple statements we repeat every day are sometimes really important in life and make us stop and take notice. It has been a couple of Sundays where we heard chapter 6, where Jesus revealed himself as the bread of life. The disciples raised a question to Jesus asking, "Where can we buy enough food for them to eat (John 6:5)?" As we say often, our Lord Jesus does not have only answers for all our questions, but he is the solution to all our problems. We had experience a great spiritual transition from a question to a quick response where the food was provided or from a scary moment to a happy celebration that led the listeners to have fragments left over.

A couple of Sundays ago, the people who were fed came back to look for Jesus and the disciples. When they found him across the sea they said to him, "Rabbi, when did you get here?" The special encounter Jesus and the disciples previously had, left a mark on the people that moved them to come back and look for him again. Jesus made an important remark saying "Amen, amen, I say to you, you are looking for me not because you saw signs but because you ate the loaves and were filled" (John 6:26). He wanted his listeners to take notice, just as he wants us to stop and ponder the truth of his words.

This Sunday we hear how the leaders of that time objected to what Jesus promised the people. They saw him as altogether too ordinary, despite the sign he had just given them in the multiplication of the loaves. They kept saying, 'is this not Jesus the Son of Joseph? Do we not know his father and mother?' This is another type of rejection of Jesus as the Son of God. During the period of this misunderstanding of Jesus as son of the heavenly father, He continued to reveal himself to the people. The great "I am" is repeated twice. I am the bread of life (John 6:41) and I am the living bread that comes down from heaven (John 6:51). However, Jesus was direct to the point saying: the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world. No other expression could have been clearer than this. Jesus gave his life for the world which includes the rich and the poor, saints and sinners, people of every race and culture. Yet, the bread and wine which are the outward appearance of the Eucharist may seem too ordinary, too simple in the eyes of many, but people of faith see that we have been given a great gift from God through his Son.

The person of Jesus continues to give himself as bread from heaven and he communicates his life in the Eucharist every day during the Eucharistic Celebration. Let us ask the Lord to increase our faith in him through our celebrations and exposition of the Blessed Sacrament. Let us open our hearts to listen to his words and his teachings every day in our lives.


