From the desk of Rev. Ernest Soprano, Retired Pastor

Dear Parishioner,

From St. Luke's Gospel we hear from Jesus *"I have come to light a fire on earth, and how I wish it were already blazing."* Not exactly a peaceful invitation for fellow believers, but one that separates fainthearted from committed believers.

In the Bible, God often appears in the form of fire. Now Jesus has come to light a fire with the fire of God's love. Fire is indeed powerful. We have seen forest fires set accidentally as well as deliberately. We also know fire can give light and strength. It can purify as well as destroy. Our Father is preparing us to live a life of eternal love. His fire burns away all that cannot live in His Presence. He is asking for a total commitment of our love.

Beloved Pope Benedict XVI wrote on this topic: the fire is *"Christ's own passion of love, a fire that is to be handed on. Whoever comes close to Him must be prepared to be burned."* This fire *"makes things bright, pure, free, and grand."*

This is why Jesus exclaims this and wants it so desperately in our lives. To be His follower means there will be difficulty indeed – division from the peace we may have preferred. His talk of *"end times"* confronts us head-on and hopefully with wide opened eyes to see, realize, and accept His Message. It leaves us with a question: Is our acceptance of Jesus and His message able to withstand the heat of our earthly opposition? If so, Lord, then blaze onward! I believe!

Saint of the Week

Mary, Mother of Jesus First Century

The greatest and first among all of our saints and a patron for all of us, Mary was chosen by God to be the mother of his son. Our greatest saint, Mary did one simple thing. She listened to God's will—that she was to be the mother of Jesus—and she accepted God's will. "*Here I am, the servant of the Lord: let it be done to me according to your word*" (Lk 1:38). Very little is known about Mary outside of the New Testament. By tradition, she was born in Jerusalem, the daughter of Joachim and Anne. Catholics believe in Mary's Immaculate Conception, which means that Mary was born without original sin, the only human so honored by God. In the Gospels of Matthew and Luke, we learn that the angel Gabriel came to Mary and announced that she was to be the mother of Jesus. We further learn about the angel's visit to Joseph; Mary's journey to visit her cousin, Elizabeth, who acknowledged her as the mother of God; and about the birth and early life of Jesus. This is most of what we know about Mary until Jesus began his ministry. Mary is mentioned from time to time in all of the Gospels. We come to know that she was instrumental in having Jesus perform his first miracle by turning water into wine at Cana. We also know that she was there at Jesus' crucifixion, and present with the disciples in Jerusalem before Pentecost. It is believed that she was also present with the apostles after Jesus' Resurrection and at the Ascension. Mary has been the intercessor for all people who call upon her and for many different causes. Over the centuries, her appearance on Earth has often been reported: at Lourdes, Fatima, La Salette, Guadalupe, and Medjagore. By tradition, Mary's birthday is celebrated on [September 8](#). Besides the Solemnity of Mary celebrated on [January 1](#), some of the other feast days on which we honor Mary are the Annunciation on [March 25](#), the Visitation on [May 31](#), the Assumption on [August 15](#), the Queenship of Mary on [August 22](#), Our Lady of Sorrows on [September 15](#), Our Lady of the Rosary on [October 7](#), the Immaculate Conception on [December 8](#) and Our Lady of Guadalupe on [December 12](#). Under the title of the Immaculate Conception, Mary is the patron of the United States. *Mary, Mother of Jesus, please pray for us.*

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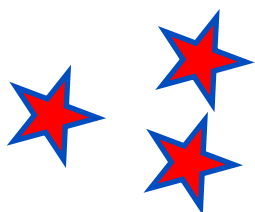
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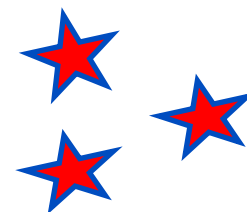

SCHOOL YEAR Family Catechesis:

Classes will be held one Sunday a month.
Parents are to join the children at class and
do assignments at home as a family.
At WCA 9:00AM to 10:10AM

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION: Preparation to receive First Eucharist, and/or Confirmation requires a two-year commitment to PREP classes as well as classes especially designed to strengthen the understanding of the sacraments. Attendance at Retreats, Service Projects and Parent meetings is also required.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL STUDENTS: All students are required to do six (6) Faith-Filled Events, outside the normal classroom setting, throughout the year. This is to help the child understand that faith happens everyday all around you. Not just in class or Mass. Notre Dame de la Mer Parish will host several events that are considered Faith-Filled Events or the family may choose to do events outside our Parish. All these experiences are considered part of the curriculum and failure to comply risks not being promoted to the next level the following year. 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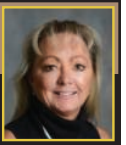
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
