



From the Desk of Father Mazz - Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

Our parish family of Notre Dame de La Mer has a very long and strong history of devotion to our Blessed Mother. We feel very proud to have two churches, one dedicated to St. Ann, the mother of Our Lady, and the other to Our Lady's Assumption into heaven.

I have been so impressed since I have been here with the faithfulness of God's people and the special devotion to the Mother of Jesus!

This weekend, while we do celebrate the 21st Sunday in Ordinary time in the liturgical calendar ,the Sunday falls on August 22 which, in the Roman calendar, is the feast of the Queenship of Mary. The title of Queen was given to Our Lady by Pope Pius XII on May 31, 1954 during the Marian year. On this feast Mary is honored as Queen of angels, patriarchs, prophets, apostles, saints, confessors and virgins, as well as Queen of peace and Queen of heaven and earth.

Last weekend we were most honored to have our Bishop here to celebrate the principal Mass for Our Lady's Assumption into heaven and to lead a procession to the ocean for the traditional blessing of the sea. What a supreme honor to have our Bishop lead us and to have so many people come out to express their deep gratitude to God for that Solemnly defined teaching. It was on November 1, 1950 that Pope Pius XII, in an apostolic constitution *Munificentissimus Deus*, proclaimed this belief as a dogma, the most solemn teaching there is. He said :

"We pronounce, declare, and define it to be a divinely revealed dogma: that the Immaculate Mother of God, the ever Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory. "

This dogma also reechoed the dogmas of Mary's Immaculate Conception , her Motherhood of God, and her perpetual virginity. We believe that Mary was assumed ("taken up") into heaven and glory by the power of God. This is different for Christ who "ascended " into heaven- by His own power. Our Lady was brought up by the power of God to be reunited with her Son, Our Risen Lord.

It is so interesting that between 1849 and 1950 approximately 113 Cardinals, 18 patriarchs, 2,505 Archbishops and bishops, 32,000 priests and men religious, 50,000 religious women, and over 8 million laypersons expressed their desire for such a dogma to be proclaimed. This dogmatic teaching gives us great confidence to prayerfully ask for the intercession of Our Blessed Mother and strengthens our faith in our own bodily resurrection- if we remain faithful to Jesus her Son.

My initial weeks in this parish have truly been a blessing for me as I have found all of you to be such beautiful Christians and so receptive to faith. Especially noteworthy is your devotion to our dear Lord in the Sacraments, His Holy Mother, and the praying of the rosary .

Please know of my prayers for each of you, your families and friends!

Sunday Readings

Reading I: Joshua 24:1-2a, 15-17, 18b

We will serve the Lord!

- The Book of Joshua describes the story of the Israelites as they take possession of the Promised Land.
- The people are a new generation of Israel.
- Joshua gathers the people in the center of the land at Shechem to renew their covenant commitment to God.

Reading II: Ephesians 5:21-32

Christ loves us as spouses love each other.

- The reading from the Letter to the Ephesians describes the mutual respect that should prevail in ordinary human relationships because of the new life shared in Christ.
- The relationship of marriage is particularly significant because the marriage relationship stands as a symbol of the covenant relationship between the people and God.
- The fidelity and love between wife and husband symbolize the fidelity and love between God and the people and between Christ and his Church.

Gospel: John 6:60-69

You have the words of eternal life.

- Jesus' divinity is clearly implied in the Gospel of John.
- In today's passage the disciples are faced with a choice.
- Peter, representing the Twelve, affirms their decision to stay with Jesus.

Family Reflection Corner

Weekly Readings Reflection

Choose one of the following activities as a way to further reflect on the Sunday readings.

- To help your family understand that Jesus is the Bread of Life Eternal, ask everyone to decorate a small prayer card with the Bible verse: "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life." Say the verse together each evening before your evening meal.
- Jesus is the Bread of Life for the world. In your diocesan newspaper, look for information about the efforts of Catholic Relief Services and the Catholic Campaign for Human Development to feed the hungry around the world. Talk about how you might become involved in these organizations.
- Take out a loaf of bread and place it on the kitchen table. Gather your family around the table. Invite each person to offer thanks for something in his or her life that God has given him or her. Break the bread and pass it around to each family member. To conclude, hold hands and pray the Lord's Prayer together.





Cremation and Proper Handling of Cremated Remain Your Choices Don't Stop with Cremation



While you may have chosen to be cremated, remember to choose your final resting place. Although the Church earnestly recommends the pious custom of burying the bodies of the dead be observed, it does not however, forbid cremation unless it has been chosen for reasons which are contrary to Christian teaching. Cremated remains are the body of the deceased in a changed form. We should honor them as we honor the body. They must be reverently buried or entombed in a place reserved for the burial of the dead. When choosing cremation, there are many choices available including:




