#### From the Desk of Sharon Mattia, Administrative Assistant

Dear Parishioner.

God works in mysterious ways! I'm sure you've had at least one life experience in which you saw the Lord's hand in the outcome. I'd like to share with you a few personal examples of God's work in my life.

My mother was a very devout woman of the Baptist faith and, as such, that was my faith as a child. I was very active in the church in my youth. However, when I married I walked away from God and all religion as did my husband. My childhood wasn't a great one and I blamed God. That being said, if it wasn't for my mother's love, example and constant prayers I'm not sure where I would have ended up. However, through the Grace of God I married a good man, we have a beautiful family and will be celebrating our 55<sup>th</sup> Wedding Anniversary this month.

My best friend was Catholic and I admired her dedication to God as well as her unfailing faith. Even through her cancer diagnosis I was astonished by her grace, trust and devotion to God. Because of her example, in my late 40's I started going to the local Catholic Church and found such an abundance of peace and solace, I decided to convert to Catholicism. However, I was concerned about my mother's reaction. When I told her what I was planning, she said, "As long as you love the Lord that is all that matters." Since my friend was my shining example of a good Catholic, I asked her to be my sponsor and I took her name at confirmation which occurred on my 50<sup>th</sup> birthday. Sadly I lost my best friend, and while I miss her terribly, I cherish the gift she gave me.

While my husband was not a "practicing" Catholic, he never really lost his conviction and belief in God and not long after my confirmation, he returned to the church. Several years later, I watched a documentary related to child abuse in the Catholic Church and once again I walked away from God; my husband however, remained strong in his faith and his love for Our Lord. During COVID we moved permanently to North Wildwood and, after COVID my husband began going to church again. Every week he would ask me to go with him. At some point I grudgingly gave in and went with him to mass. During that mass, it was as if Father Soprano was talking directly to me. He talked about the abuse within the church and said (I'm paraphrasing) you're not here for anyone else; you're here to establish a relationship with God. I sobbed through the entire mass. I began to attend Mass on a regular basis and I continued to cry throughout each Mass, especially when the Adult Choir sang! I thought if I joined the choir I would stop crying. I eventually did join the choir and I cry occasionally, however, a certain choir member is not shy about telling me to "pull it together!"

Last year I began going to the Parish Office once a week for a few hours to help gather music for the choir and was fortunate enough to get to know Mary Vey. A few months later, Mary became ill, and as you can imagine, without Mary at the helm, the office was in a state. I felt compelled to offer help and did so one day a week, all the while anticipating Mary's return. Sadly it didn't seem as though that would happen, so I ended up helping out every day. When it was evident Mary was not going to be able to return, the office was looking for someone on a permanent basis; I raised my hand and what a blessing this entire experience has been!

I never intended to work after I retired, but God knew. He knew he was going to call Mary home and had a plan. I know I could never replace Mary and her value to this Parish and Community, nor would I try. Though I struggle that I am in this role because of the loss of a very dear and important person, I am very grateful for the opportunity as well as the kindness that has been extended to me by all of you. Thank you and may God Bless each and every one of you always!

#### Saint of the Week:

# Augustine, Bishop and Doctor, 354-430 Feast Day is August 28

As a young man, Augustine studied at the University at Carthage with the intent of becoming a lawyer but gave up law to devote himself to literary pursuits. Along the way, he abandoned his Christian faith. In Milan, Augustine was impressed by the sermons of St. Ambrose, the bishop of the city. His influence, as well as the prayers of his mother, brought him back to Christianity and he was baptized by Ambrose at the Easter Vigil in 387.

Augustine was ordained a priest at Hippo and, three years later, became the Bishop of Hippo. Though he preferred the monastic life, Augustine became the dominant figure in African church affairs, writing profusely, preaching, and defending the faith.

His towering intellect has molded the thought of Western Christianity to such an extent that his ideas dominated the thinking of the western world for a thousand years after his death. He and Thomas Aquinas are considered to be the greatest intellects the Catholic Church has ever produced.

St. Augustine is the patron saint of brewers, printers, and theologians.




