Dear Parishioners,

On Labor Day Weekend, we acknowledge the work and labor we accomplish throughout the year. And we ask God's blessing on what we do for Him and for one another's salvation.

The Church has always valued work as essential for the good of humanity and the individual. Pope Francis has said, "We were created with a vocation to work . . . Work is a necessity, part of the meaning of life on this earth, a path to growth, human development and personal fulfillment" (Laudato Si, 127-128).

In his writings, St. Paul says that we are to "work out [our] salvation" (Philippians 2:12). And elsewhere he writes, "For to this end we labor and strive, because we have our hope set on the living God, who is the Savior of all men, especially of them that believe" (1 Timothy 4:10). Above all, the goal and purpose of work is to work for God, "Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as though you were working for the Lord, and not for yourselves" (Colossians 3:23-24).

The Catechism explains, "Our work honors the Creator's gifts and the talents received from him. It can also be redemptive. By enduring the hardship of work in union with Jesus, the carpenter of Nazareth and the one crucified on Calvary, man collaborates in a certain fashion with the Son of God in his redemptive work" (CCC 2427).

The patron saint of workers is Saint Joseph. As his legal father, he "teaches Jesus his trade. Jesus is born in a family, in the Holy Family, learning the carpenters' craft from St. Joseph in his workshop in Nazareth, sharing with him the commitment, effort, satisfaction and also the difficulties of every day. This reminds us of the dignity and importance of work" (Pope Francis, General Audience, 5/1/13).

In this year of 2021, dedicated by Pope Francis to St. Joseph, may we find courage and health in our day-to-day work and tasks. And may our daily labor we do throughout the year be fruitful and blessed by God's abundance.

Reading I: [Isaiah 35:4-7a](#)

Be strong! Fear not!

- Today's reading from Isaiah looks forward to a coming age of glory, when all Israel's infirmities will be abolished.
- This will be the age of the messiah; God's anointed one, who comes to bring salvation to Israel.
- The power of evil will no longer manifest itself in sickness or afflictions of any kind.

Reading II: [James 2:1-5](#)

Did not God choose the poor to become rich in faith?

- The reading from James draws our attention to affliction and oppression.
- If you shun people with physical impairments and those who are poor, you have missed Jesus' message.
- Faith in Jesus is expressed by working to free oppressed people.

Gospel: [Mark 7:31-37](#)

He makes the deaf hear!

- Today's Gospel story portrays Jesus' healing as the fulfillment of Isaiah's prophecy.
- The deaf man with the speech impairment who is brought to Jesus is a Gentile.
- The man is healed when Jesus touches the parts of him that are weak and impaired.

Family Reflection Corner

Weekly Readings Reflection

Choose one of the following activities as a way to further reflect on the Sunday readings.

- The more we are open to Jesus in our lives the more we understand our need for him. Take a moment of silence this week and ask God to open your ears, eyes, mind and heart to the power of Jesus.
- Jesus opened the ears of the deaf and cured the mute so that they could speak. Whom do you know who might feel separated or lonely because of a disability? Discuss as a family how you can reach out to the person.
- Take turns experimenting with the experience of being unable to speak or see or walk. Did you feel left out? Who helped you feel as if you were part of the group? How does Jesus help you to hear and speak?
- Prejudices can be subtle, such as jokes told about people of a certain ethnic or national heritage. Discuss as a family how you can respond to this kind of humor.







Cremation and Proper Handling of Cremated Remains Your Choices Don't Stop with Cremation



While you may have chosen to be cremated, remember to choose your final resting place. Although the Church earnestly recommends the pious custom of burying the bodies of the dead be observed, it does not however, forbid cremation unless it has been chosen for reasons which are contrary to Christian teaching. Cremated remains are the body of the deceased in a changed form. We should honor them as we honor the body. They must be reverently buried or entombed in a place reserved for the burial of the dead. When choosing cremation, there are many choices available including:


