Letter From Father Yvans Jazon



Dear Parishioners,

I want to start by thanking all of you who have been so generous with your donation of School supplies to help Hand-to-Hand Mission to Haiti's project to reach their goal of enough school supplies for 2000 Haitian children for next January's mission trip. The Hand-to-Hand Mission to Haiti will always remember you in their prayers and remain forever grateful.

The common theme of today's readings is God's command concerning spiritual responsibility and our individual accountability for others in our families, parishes and community, which rises from our identity as God's children and as brothers and sisters in Christ. The liturgy of this Sunday makes us aware of the responsibilities which we have for each other. As we have been through the Labor Day weekend, the weather did not cooperate so well with all of us who wanted to have fun on the beach or organize backyard or barbecues. Well the only thing that weather forecasters could do was to announce it. They make sure they let all of us know how the weather will be. That teaches us we do not have a control over mother Nature. Thank God, Monday was a beautiful day, so I hope everyone had a fun day. In the same way, we know storms arise in the life of people whom we know and love. Like the weather service, we can turn away from some personal storms, especially when we receive early enough warnings.

God has appointed us as watchmen for each other as he appointed the prophet Ezekiel. Through the gospel we discover, once again, that we are keepers of our brothers and sisters with the painful responsibility of lovingly and prudently correcting our erring brothers and sisters. However, it is never easy to warn others that they are about to trip and fall, but this individual responsibility in a Christian culture includes fraternal correction of other member and our obligation to forgive our offenders, and to ask forgiveness from others for our offenses. Jesus teaches us in the gospel the characteristic of a true and faithful Christian. True Christian charity obliges a Christian not only to assist his neighbors in their temporal and spiritual needs with material help and prayer, but also with correction and counsel for an erring brother or sister who has offended us and our community. If the erring one refuses a one-on-one loving correction by the offended party, then the Christian is to try to involve more people without the intention to betray, to ruin the reputation of the erring brother or sister, or to condemn and complain about one another. This is something that requires love, compassion, and the virtue of prudence. Anytime that we face a situation where we need either to reconcile or to admonish someone we need to do that with the purpose of spiritual growth, but not to be right, or wrong, and not to accuse.

The gospel does not ask us to point fingers or complain about our brothers and sisters, but it gives us the tools to have a successful Christian life full of grace and blessing. In a certain sense the gospel asks us to practice the virtue of charity. Yes, in so many aspects of our life we need to be our brother's or sister's keeper by fraternally opening our heart to carefully advise and give spiritual direction. Therefore, Jesus does not want us to be the downfall of our brothers and sisters, but instead to be the spiritual bridge that will lead them to Christ. When one of our family members falls, the whole family suffers. Therefore, by being a charitable Christian is a way to share our love for one another and to express our gratitude to our forgiving God.

May God continue to bless you and fill you with His love and compassion as you go forth to share His love and compassion with your brothers and sisters.
