Letter From AnnaMae Muryasz



Dear Parishioners,

“That’s not fair!” Words most of you as parents have heard over and over from your children many times. Words that you have tried to explain to your children by telling them their age matters, their size matters, and even whether they are a boy or a girl matters in the situation they are saying is “not fair”.

God created each of us in His image and likeness but we all have different hair colors and we are different sizes and so forth. Fairness!!! A word that only God can truly make “fair”. Fairness and justice walk side by side. Without fairness there would be no justice. Fairness reminds us that we want our rights respected. But on the other hand it also means we have duties to fulfill.

God, the creator of all, is responsible for all the many blessings we enjoy each day of our lives. Life in this world was given to each of us as an underserved, free gift. We each possess unequal physical talents, features, and abilities, plus diverse spiritual and intellectual gifts as well. They vary a lot from person to person, but what they all have in common is that they come as free gifts from God who didn’t have to create any of us.

When we think of all our individual gifts we can visualize the last line of the gospel today come to life.... “I give what I want.... God’s ways are not my ways”. We would all like to receive more to keep for the rainy day or for tomorrow, but God promised to give each of us enough for the day at hand. And then He promised to give enough for the next day and so on. As in the gospel story with the land owner God has the ability to be generous with each of us as He alone sees fit.

In the same generosity of the landowner the Lord gives out of his extraordinary generosity and he offers us a deal --- if we will accept his beloved Son in faith as Savior and Lord, and through the power of the Spirit seek to do His will, and if we will repent each time we fail, he will give us what we do not deserve – friendship—His friendship with Him that will take us to Eternity. The first to accept this gift have been those that recognize their need for mercy. And this then is why the last have usually been first when it comes to the Kingdom of God. They are usually the first to see their need for mercy.
Go forth this week showing mercy and asking the LORD alone to direct your life.




