



Message from Deacon Nick Danze, Pastoral Associate

Dear Parishioners,

Consider this... He helps her with her coat and makes sure she has a good, steady grip on her cane. He then puts her arm in his and they walk the same path they walk every afternoon in the park across the street from their apartment. He points to a cardinal on a tree branch overhead. He talks about last night's call from their son and the latest doings of the grandchildren. But none of it registers with her. She is lost in a fog of dementia. All she recognizes is him, her husband of 63 years. And that's more than enough. He's thankful that they can walk arm-in-arm together for another day.

Jesus' simple story of the two sons takes the Gospel out of the realm of the "theoretical" and places the mercy of God right in the middle of our busy, complicated everyday lives. Compassion, forgiveness and mercy are only words until our actions give full expression to those values in our relationships with others; you see, our simply calling ourselves disciples of Jesus mean nothing until our lives express that identity in the values and beliefs we uphold.

My friends, the words of the Gospel must be lived; Jesus' teachings on justice, reconciliation and love must be the light that guides us, the path we walk, and the prayer we work to make a reality. Truth be told, discipleship begins within our hearts, where we realize Christ's presence in our lives and in the lives of others and then honoring that presence in real and meaningful acts of compassion and charity.

Throughout the Gospels, Jesus upholds the sacred dignity of all men and women in the eyes of God: the struggling, the poor, the powerless, the ignored, the forgotten, the vulnerable, those pushed to the margins and peripheries of society. Every life is open to the "way of righteousness": simple humility, faithfulness and gratitude are the entries to the kingdom of God.

Actually, our net worth, whatever labels society applies to us do not determine the "holiness" of our lives or the measure of God's love in our days. Christ invites us to realize the kingdom of God in our lives by our commitment to selfless generosity and faithful gratitude; indeed, He calls us to look beyond the designations and stereotypes like "tax collector" and "prostitute" and recognize, instead, the holiness that resides within the soul of every person — including ourselves.

May God our Father give you Grace and Peace!
