

CREATOR AND CREATION

"In the beginning, God created Heaven and Earth".

This is how the scriptures of the Bible begin. We are reminded of the real fact that there is a beginning to all things created. In other words, there is a Creator and Creation. Many religions and cultures and philosophies and institutions even into modern times have held this understanding as true and meaningful for humanity as a whole and for the individual. Our own *Declaration of Independence* as well clearly mentions them in some of its very first lines.

Our Holy Father, Pope Francis, wrote recently, "I strongly encourage the Faithful to pray in these days [September 1 to October 4] that, as the result of a timely ecumenical initiative, are being celebrated as a *Season of Creation*". To explain his message on this topic, he has written an encyclical in 2015, *Laudato Si', On Care for our Common Home*.

We as Catholics do believe in a Creator, who is God and the "I am who am" of the Judeo-Christian tradition. We can come to know the existence of God by our own reason, not just by faith, "For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes, His eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly seen, being understood through what has been made" (*Rom 1:20*). God is, then, an Uncreated Being and exists always as eternal and infinite, "Behold, God is exalted, and we do not know Him; the number of His years is unsearchable" (*Job 36:26*).

God is the Most High, transcendent above all things, and without help he creates *ex-nihilo* (*from nothing*), "For he spoke and it came to be" (*cf. Gen 1*). Considered in ancient terms as the *Unmoved Mover* and the *Uncaused Cause*, God sustains Creation in existence, "He is before all things and in him all things hold together" (*Col 1:17*).

Nevertheless, Creation, though subordinate in nature and essence to its Creator, has a certain dignity in its own right, for "God saw that it was good ... very good" (*cf. Gen. 1-2*). In his Divine Providence, God provides for all things as Christ tells us he does with the birds of the air, the grass, the lilies of the field, and even more us when he provides for humanity (*cf. Mt. 6: 25-34*).

Let us, then, ponder, pray and even reassess these foundational elements of our faith and common traditions, especially during the final days of the *Season of Creation*, which ends on the feast day of the very widely celebrated St. Francis of Assisi. Also good to mention that today, on September 29th, it is the day of the archangels, Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael.

May all of Creation bless the Lord and may we feel strengthened and supported by the Maker of Heaven and Earth, as we proclaim in the *Sanctus* during Mass, "Holy, Holy, Holy, Lord God of Hosts! Heaven and Earth are full of Your glory! Hosanna in the Highest!"

Family Reflection Corner

Weekly Readings Reflections

26th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Choose one of the following activities as a way to further reflect on the Sunday readings:

- As a family, make plans to do one activity in the coming weeks that shows your responsibility to the poor and needy. After you have completed your project or activity, talk about how you as a family can continue to care for the poor and needy on an ongoing basis.
- At the evening meal, have each member of the family take a turn leading a personal prayer for the poor and for all of those who serve the poor.
- Play a game with your child to see how many of God's gifts you both can name. On a large sheet of paper, write across the top: *Top 25 Gifts from God*. Have your child start by naming one of God's gifts. Then you name a gift. Alternate back and forth with your child and see if you can come up with twenty-five gifts. Say a prayer of thanksgiving to God for what you have been given. Ask for the grace to share your gifts with others.



Liturgy Corner...learn something new or maybe even become inspired !

Question: Why do we have the Liturgy of the Word and the Liturgy of the Eucharist?

Answer: The Mass is broken up into two parts: The Liturgy of the Word and the Liturgy of the Eucharist. The Liturgy of the Word is the first half of the Mass. This begins with the sign of the cross and contains the readings from Sacred Scriptures, the homily, the profession of faith and the prayer of the faithful. In this Liturgy, we hear of the Paschal Mystery (the suffering, death, resurrection, and ascension of our Lord) as foretold in the Old Testament (the first reading) and expressed during the time of the Apostles (second reading) and the challenge of participating in the Paschal Mystery today (Gospel and homily).

The Second half of the Mass is the Liturgy of the Eucharist. This part of the Liturgy contains the offertory, the consecration, the Our Father, the reception of Holy Communion and the final blessing. This part of the Mass is the sacrificial aspect. In the Liturgy of the Word we hear of the Paschal Mystery, but in the Liturgy of the Eucharist, the Paschal Mystery is made present! The Eucharist is the “re-living” sacrifice of Christ. The crucifixion was an act in time, yet Christ, our *Eternal* High Priest, is not in time but rather out of time. Therefore, he is making one continual sacrifice to the Father and invites us to participate in this Paschal Mystery.

The two liturgies are inseparable. One without the other would not be the Mass. We can see these two liturgies as early as the first Easter Sunday. On the Road to Emmaus, Jesus read and explained the Scriptures to the two men on the road (Liturgy of the Word) and broke bread with them (Liturgy of the Eucharist).

Parish Religious Education Program

Our Parish has a few choices for anyone wishing to receive their sacraments and become Catholic:

Children in 1st-8th grade can either do our **School Year** program, which is held on scheduled Sundays, September-May at 9am followed by the 10:30 am mass at St. Ann's. Or our **Summer Intensive** program, which begins the last Monday in July through first week in August.

Teenagers in 9th-12th grade will be given a **RCIA** program geared to their age group.

Adults seeking the faith will be entered into the **RCIA** program. **RCIA** usually meets once a week starting in September and going through the Easter Season.




