# Readings of the Week

#### Reading I: Numbers 11:25-29

Moses shared his gifts among the people.

- The first reading from Numbers addresses the individuals who assisted Moses in the leadership of the people.
- The seventy elders have authority because God's Spirit has been bestowed on them.
- Moses reminds Joshua that the focus is to be on God and not on earthly leaders.

#### Reading II: James 5:1-6

Let the rich be warned!

- The letter from James reprimands Christians for their excessive concern with earthly riches.
- These have become an obstacle to their faith.
- Not only are they inordinately possessive of what they have accumulated, but they have grown rich at the expense of others.

#### Gospel: Mark 9:38-43, 45, 47-48

Anyone who is not against us is for us.

- John presumes that any person who is not part of the apostle's group should not invoke Jesus' name in ministry.
- Jesus points out that anyone who recognizes his name whether or not the person belongs to the community, will be rewarded because the person honors Jesus' name.
- In the latter part of the passage Jesus uses highly figurative language to emphasize that nothing is more important than belonging to the reign of God, no matter what the cost.

#### FATIMA PROCESSION—OCT. 12th

On October 12, at 9am following morning Mass, for the Fourth year in a row, Notre Dame de la Mer will be part of the nationwide Rosary process, celebrating that "America needs Fatima."

Last year, all across the United States, faithful Catholics gathered together in public squares to pray the rosary as one in October. ## Saint of the Week:

Vincent de Paul, Priest, c.1580-1660

Vincent was born at Pouy, France, in 1581. He was educated at the college at Dax and at the University of Toulouse and was then ordained at the early age of twenty. Vincent's ambition was little more than to have a comfortable life. Certainly, there was no sign of the great things which Vincent was to accomplish in later years. However, he became aware of the spiritual needs of the poor people of France. Vincent began preaching to the poor and soon left the house of his patron to become pastor of a church. There he instructed the people in the necessity for repentance and converted many from a scandalous lifestyle.

The following years brought wide renown to Vincent de Paul. He became noted for his work among the poor, and was a chaplain to galley slaves waiting to be shipped abroad. In 1625, with the help of his former patron, the Count de Joigny, Vincent founded the Congregation of the Missions (known today as the Vincentians), an order devoted to work among the peasants. In 1633, along with Saint Louise de Marillac, he founded the Sisters of Charity. His feast day is September 27.

Vincent's message today: Even though he was ordained a priest at an early age, it took an awakening event for Vincent to recognize what God was calling him to do. The same is true for many of us, no matter what age we are. God may be asking us to do more.




