

Dear Friends in Christ,

Peace to you, your family and friends!

Beginning a new season is a wonderful time to renew our hearts and open ourselves up to the need to forgive. I recently read an article, “The Fading of Forgiveness” by Timothy Keller, which gives an excellent view of what’s NOT happening in our world today, **FORGIVENESS**. What are the influences that are making forgiveness problematic in our culture? The first factor is a therapeutic culture. our culture has taken a strongly inward turn. The second influence impoverishing the modern practice of forgiveness is a rising shame and honor culture that some have called a secular religion. This looking out only for our own good and not that of others is killing humanity. Forgiveness is not, primarily and originally an emotion. Forgiveness is granted before it is experienced. The practices can slowly shrink the internal anger over time, and that is a great good to be expected, but forgiveness is practiced before felt, not felt before practiced. The main way Christians can be a resource to the broader culture is by restoring the church to being a well-known community of forgiveness and reconciliation. Is there a family member you haven’t talked to in years? You must initiate the process of forgiveness immediately. Christians come together not because they form a natural collocation, but because they have all been saved by Jesus Christ and owe him a common allegiance. In this light we are a band of natural enemies who love one another for Jesus’ sake.

Comenzar una nueva temporada es un momento maravilloso para renovar nuestro corazón y abrirnos a la necesidad de perdonar. Recientemente leí un artículo, “El desvanecimiento del perdón” de Timothy Keller, que brinda una excelente visión de lo que NO está sucediendo en nuestro mundo de hoy, **EL PERDÓN**. ¿Cuáles son las influencias que hacen que el perdón sea problemático en nuestra cultura? El primer factor es una cultura terapéutica. nuestra cultura ha dado un fuerte giro hacia adentro. La segunda influencia que empobrece la práctica moderna del perdón es una creciente cultura de la vergüenza y el honor que algunos han llamado religión secular. Este mirar solo por nuestro propio bien y no el de los demás está matando a la humanidad. El perdón no es, primaria y originalmente, una emoción. El perdón se concede antes de experimentarlo. Las prácticas pueden reducir lentamente la ira interna con el tiempo, y eso es un gran bien de esperarse, pero el perdón se practica antes de sentir, no se siente antes de practicar. La principal forma en que los cristianos pueden ser un recurso para la cultura en general es restaurando la iglesia para que sea una comunidad reconocida de perdón y reconciliación. ¿Hay algún miembro de la familia con el que no ha hablado en años? Debes iniciar el proceso de perdón de inmediato. Los cristianos se unen no porque formen una ubicación natural, sino porque todos han sido salvados por Jesucristo y le debemos una lealtad común. En este sentido, somos una banda de enemigos naturales que se aman unos a otros por amor a Jesús.

Sunday Readings

Reading I: Genesis 2:18-24

I will make a partner for him.

- The creation story in Genesis 2 portrays God as searching for an equal partner for the human.
- Only a creature that shares the same flesh will be a fitting partner.
- The union between man and woman is so central that they long to reunite in the one flesh they share.

Reading II: Hebrews 2:9-11

They are all brothers.

- In Jesus we see the true nature of God.
- Today's second reading points out that Jesus accepted death for the sake of all.
- Jesus is the perfect leader because he shared in our weakness and suffering.

Gospel: Mark 10:2-16

Let the children come to me.

- In response to the Pharisees question about divorce, Jesus compares the passage in Deuteronomy, which is simply a concession to human weakness, to the creation story in Genesis, which emphasizes the indissolubility of marriage.
- Jesus presents the ideal of the marriage bond to stress the truth that in him, sin has no power in the world.
- In the final passage of today's Gospel, Jesus proclaims that the kingdom belongs to those who receive it as children.

Choose one of the following activities as a way to further reflect on the Sunday readings.

- Jesus embraced and blessed the children in today's Gospel story. Begin a practice of blessing your children. Search your parish or diocesan library for books of Catholic blessings and prayers that are suitable for families.
- Jesus speaks of marriage as a union joined by God. Think about a married couple that you admire. What are signs of their love for one another? Do they help one another to grow? What do they teach others about the love of God?
- Get out the family photo album and share with your family some memories of family wedding days. Discuss the expectations of the people marrying and how their faith sustained them.
