Dear Parishioners,

Since last week the Lord has been talking to us in parables through the gospels. Just a recapitulation about last week, it was the parable about the two sons that was taken from Matthew 21:28-32. This weekend's parable sounds like the Song of the Vineyard in Isaiah 5-6 (please take a time to read it). A man owned a domain; he planted a vineyard, surrounded it with a fence, dug a wine press there and built a watchtower. The owner surrounds his vineyard with the same care as the vine-grower of Isaiah; but the similarities end there. In Isaiah, the owner is at the same time the vine-grower; the vineyard represents the people of Israel, and the vintners are the chief priests and the Pharisees. It is a vineyard surrounded by care, but disappointing by yielding only bad fruit. They rejected his message because they mistreated all the prophets and ultimately they were rejecting the Beloved Son of the Father.

In the parable of Jesus, the owner is not the vine-grower, he does not exploit his vine directly, he entrusts it to other vine-growers. It seems to be speaking about the vineyard as God's people, the vinedressers as his religious leaders, the son as the gospel message of Jesus Christ, his murder the rejection of that message by the chosen people and their leaders and the threat that the kingdom of God will be given to a nation bringing forth the fruits from the vineyard. In the gospel, the parable takes a new turn and proposes a new lesson. Sometimes, parables have two levels of meaning, the first to those to whom it was originally addressed, and the second as it has come to be understood and used in and by the church.

On the other hand, it must not be forgotten that a parable is never a verdict, but a call to conversion; it is true that from one parable to another, in this last stage of Jesus' life, the tone rises, but it is because the urgency of the recognition of the Messiah is pressing. We must never lose sight of the fact that Jesus' constant wish is to save but not to condemn us. His desires are to cure his compatriots and all those who are away from the truth because of their blindness. This parable was the ultimate attempt of Jesus to alert the Pharisees and to teach them about the urgency of his words, but they are not a final judgment.

As a reflection for this weekend we might ask ourselves these following questions. As Faithfull Catholic Christians, are we good fruit-producers in the vineyard of the Church? Jesus has given us the Church, and through her everything necessary to make Christians fruit-bearing: He gave us the teachings in the Bible to know the will of God, the priesthood to lead the people in God's ways, the Sacraments to nourish our faith, so we are expected to make use of these gifts and produce fruits for God. Are we fruit-producers in the vineyard of the family? By the mutual sharing of blessings, by sacrificing time and talents for the members of the family, by humbly and lovingly serving others in the family, by recognizing and encouraging each other and by honoring and gracefully obeying our parents we become producers of "good fruit" for the Vine, for Christ, in our families.

May God bless you all see you at the Charismatic Conference.


