

Message From Carolyn Miller, Parish Catechetical Leader



Dear Friends,

This weekend the Wildwoods are celebrating the Fabulous Fifties. Those “Oldies but Goodies” tunes ring out everywhere we go reminding us of the way things used to be. Nostalgic for sure. This past week, Catholics celebrated another remarkable time in those Fabulous Fifties (and Sixties) but without much fanfare at all.

The Second Vatican Council was called to order on Oct. 11, 1962 and forever changed the role of our church in the modern world. John XXIII (now a saint) was elected to the papacy in October, 1958, at the age of 77. It was assumed he would be a ‘mere caretaker’ and bridge what was expected to be a short gap until the next pope came into office. About three months into his tenancy, Pope John called for an ecumenical council, the first in 100 years. Pope John’s surprise announcement was a call “to open the windows and let in some fresh air.”

Just as the music of the 50s and 60s influenced and colored our world, the ‘music’ coming from Rome, reverberated through the Catholic Church. Not all of it resounded well on the ear of the Catholic in the pew but for those of you younger than 60, your church experience is rooted in those amazing alterations and enhancements. Here are just a few reminders:

- * The Mass had always been ‘said’ in Latin with the priest’s back to the congregation. Calling for ‘active participation,’ priests now face the people and celebrate the Mass in the language of the community.
- * Women are welcome to serve as Lectors, Ministers of the Eucharist and altar servers and pastors are encouraged to include women in the decision making process.
- * Catholics are no longer forbidden to attend Protestant services and the rules regarding ‘mixed-marriages’ have been eased. There has been a major outreach to the Jewish Community. Ecumenism is seen as a movement to be embraced.
- * Reading the Bible is encouraged as a spiritual practice.
- * Social justice issues and workers’ rights are brought to the forefront and discussed openly.
- * The title “Mary, Mother of the Church” is declared and promulgated as doctrine by John’s successor Paul VI.
- * New possibilities are granted for choosing music and accompaniment in liturgical celebrations. Cultural selections as well as modern influences (piano, guitar, drums) enhance the experience. Hymns such as “Here I Am Lord” and “On Eagle’s Wings” are now favorite “Oldies but Goodies” birthed by the council. A pre-Vatican II church would not have approved.

To be sure, I am a bit nostalgic about singing Panis Angelicus and Sister Mary Martha’s black habit with the rosary rustling at her side, but if the goal of Vatican II was to present a church alive and relevant in the Modern World, then that is our charge today. We are responsible for our church; it is we who must take the Light of Christ to everyone.
