Letter From Father Joseph Wallace

Dear Parishioner,

As residents of a barrier island, we know the devastation that hurricanes can inflict in just a few short hours. Our friends in Haiti last week endured the high winds and heavy flooding that came their way from Hurricane Matthew. Thankfully, we were spared the ravages of Matthew. Haiti, however, was in the crosshairs of this terrible storm. Haiti which is still trying to slowly recover from the catastrophic damage inflicted on them by the earthquake just six years ago is now dealing with this terrible setback inflicted upon them by Matthew. In one of the poorest countries of the world where the common family has no home insurance or property insurance, their loss is total and their situation is dire.

This past summer our parish had the honor of having Cardinal Chibly Langlois visit and celebrate Mass. He thanked our parish for its ongoing efforts to help Haiti. Who would have thought that just a few months later his Cathedral would be partially destroyed and that his residence would lose its roof from this terrible hurricane? Fr. Yvans has been in touch with him and with many of his relatives and friends in receiving updates on the devastation. Fr. Yvans said that the worst of the hurricane hit Cardinal Langlois' diocese in the southern part of Haiti. The hurricane caused terrible mud slides and has left thousands of people homeless. The situation is grave for so many of our friends in Haiti.

Our parish began an annual mission to Haiti last year which I had the privilege of joining. I saw firsthand the lingering effects of the earthquake and can only imagine the set back to any progress caused by this hurricane. Our parish, through the pastoral direction of both our Pastoral Council and Finance Committee, has committed to periodic collections that would help Cardinal Langlois in his efforts to help his suffering people in Haiti. Fr. Yvans and his Hand to Hand Mission has been helping vulnerable orphans in Haiti by collecting school supplies and shoes for these wonderful children. This January we are planning our second mission to Haiti as a parish and school community.

I would like to thank you all for your ongoing generosity to our friends in Haiti. We are committed to continue our efforts to help in various ways to alleviate the suffering of our brothers and sisters. Please keep Cardinal Langlois and his diocese in your prayers.

Sacraments

Pre-Baptismal Classes: As the primary educators of their child, the parents/guardians and godparents have the most important influence on the faith development of children and parishes must provide catechesis for them before their child is baptized. Notre Dame de la Mer Parish offers six Baptism Preparation Classes throughout the year. It is important for the expectant parents/guardians to arrange to attend a session **5 months before the birth and Baptism** of the child. Contact the parish offices for more information. **The next class is scheduled for Saturday, November 5, 2016, from 9:30 to 11:00 AM.**

Funerals: To be arranged with a priest and funeral director.

Sacrament of the Sick: Anytime

Marriage: Arrangements should be made one year in advance and prior to making reception plans.

Notre Dame de la Mer Baptism Changes

Beginning this month, October 2016 Baptism will be celebrated after the 10:30 a.m. Mass on the Fourth Sunday of each month. In the months of March, June, September and December each year Baptism will also be celebrated during the 10:30 a.m. Mass on the Second Sunday of the month. In December of 2016 there will be **no baptisms** after the 10:30 a.m. Mass on the Fourth Sunday due to the fact that the Fourth Sunday is Christmas Day. Please check the parish website for a list of the baptism dates for the next year.

It is also suggested that if you will be celebrating the sacrament of Baptism in the near future and need to attend a baptismal preparation class that you look ahead and attend the class before your child is born. In the same way that you prepare for the birth of your child with clothing and furniture and a new room you need to prepare for your child in the faith by attending the baptismal preparation class and selecting appropriate godparents who can help you with your child's growth in the faith.

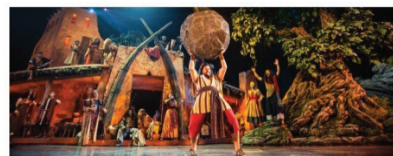
