Letter From Sister Rosaline Walters

Dear Parishioners,

How's your faith? In case you were unaware, faith has tremendous power. Like a seed it holds and gives birth to new life. That's Jesus message in today's readings. Let's ask ourselves a couple of questions. Is my faith waning due to prayers I have said for a special intention and they don't seem to be answered; or because we have scandals in our Church; or because we have gay or lesbian members in our families? Are these and other problems causing us to hold on to our faith by a thread? Be consoled because this thread is enough for Jesus. Faith lives within us. It is the center of our lives, and of our relationships. Faith gives us a reason for existence and a purpose for living – it animates our whole being.

If you look in your Bible, the sentence before our 2nd reading of today describes how Timothy came to believe in Jesus. What we believe becomes evident in the way we think and act. Have we ever said: I don't know how people handle this or that without faith? Our faith is the basis for what we say, and how we act? Jesus tells us that faith is able to command a sycamore tree to be uprooted from the ground and replanted in the sea. We might say if we plant it in the sea it will die. But this exaggerated statement is used to make a point – that faith can do the impossible. Faith can move mountains. Do we not expect God to solve all our problems; to heal all our ills? But our faith may become weak when our prayers to God seemingly go unanswered. We need to ask ourselves if our worries or concerns are from God or another human being. We need to see God as our friend, not as a punisher who sends evil into our lives. We need to use Jesus, God's Son as our model. Jesus did not free himself from suffering, pain or even death, but suffered and died in order to attain, for us, new life; and, also, to be an example to us.

This brings us to Luke's gospel for today, where we read; "Who can eat at Jesus' table?" Jesus eats with everyone and anyone. The master in today's gospel does not invite his slave to sit down and eat and drink with him. Instead, Jesus tells the servant he may eat after serving his master's meal. This parable teaches us not to become status seekers, but to see ourselves as slaves with the duty to serve others just as Jesus had done. Jesus came "to serve others rather than be served." Jesus was willing to eat with the poor, women, fishermen, Pharisees, and even tax collectors. Therefore, we should be challenged not to discriminate socially against others due to status, gender, or social inequalities. We need to remember that black lives matter; blue lives matter; and all people of all faiths and circumstances matter. Let your faith be your guide!





Cremation Burial | Group Funeral & Committal Service

Saturday, October 29, 2016 |Check-in at 9 AM St. Maximilian Kolbe Parish | Marmora, NJ and Resurrection Cemetery | Clermont, NJ

Yes, cremation is an accepted practice for Catholics. The Church earnestly recommends the pious custom of burying the bodies of the dead be observed. It does not however, forbid cremation unless it has been chosen for reasons which are contrary to Christian teaching 1983 Code of Canon Law.

Cremated remains are the body of the deceased in a changed form, and we should honor them as we honor the body. They must be reverently buried or entombed in a place reserved for the burial of the dead. Since the human body was the temple of the Holy Spirit during life, was fed at the Eucharistic table, and will share in the bodily resurrection, contemporary cultural practices like scattering the cremated remains over water or from the air or keeping the cremated remains at home are not considered reverent forms of disposition that the Church requires. Other practices such as combining multiple sets of cremated remains or dividing up cremated remains among family members or friends are not acceptable for Catholics.

South Jersey Catholic Cemeteries is offering to bury cremated remains that you have in your possession. We are happy to make this offer at no cost to you. On Saturday, October 29, 2016, we will hold a funeral mass at St. Kolbe Maximilian Parish in Marmora followed by a group committal service at Resurrection Cemetery. In order to accommodate all who require this service, pre-registration is required. The deadline is Monday, October 24, 2016. 
