Letter From Sister Rosaline Walters

Dear Friends,

How many of us have experienced a Zacchaeus moment in our lives? A time when we have been caught speechless by a particular person or event (surprise). The Gospel today has two of my most favorite characters portrayed. The first, of course, is Jesus and the second Zacchaeus.

In today's gospel, Jesus surprises Zacchaeus by inviting himself to Zacchaeus' house for dinner. Saint Luke describes Zacchaeus as being a tax collector and short in stature. Zacchaeus, being short and wanting very much to see Jesus as he passed along the way to the city of Jericho. The path was lined with many people. Since Zacchaeus was so short, he decided to climb a sycamore (fig) tree in order to catch a glimpse of this man who raised Lazarus from the dead and restored sight to the blind man, Bartimaeus. As Jesus reached the tree where Zacchaeus was perched, he looked up, saw him, and told him to "hurry down" because he had to stay at his house. As the crowd began to witness Jesus' actions they began to talk among themselves. The name Zacchaeus means "clean", but in the eyes of the town's people Zacchaeus was not clean. According to Jewish Law, Zacchaeus was classified as a sinner. He was rejected by his own people because he was a tax collector for the Romans and not one of the law abiding townspeople.

As Jesus neared the sycamore tree, where Zacchaeus had perched, he looked up and saw Zacchaeus, and called him by name. We might assume that they had met before, or that Jesus may have known him because of his work as tax collector – no matter what the reason – it was an opportunity for Jesus to teach us that we should reach out to all and embrace them. We know that Jesus came to seek out and save the lost. Zacchaeus, in answer to Jesus' call, pledged half his possessions to the poor and promised to repay anyone he defrauded, four times the amount.

Could we be like Zacchaeus and look at our own status? Do we consider the common good? And do we extend ourselves outside our comfort zone? Each time we receive Communion, we are inviting Jesus into our house. Have we allowed him to change us?

Pre-Baptismal Classes: As the primary educators of their child, the parents/guardians and godparents have the most important influence on the faith development of children and parishes must provide catechesis for them before their child is baptized. Notre Dame de la Mer Parish offers six Baptism Preparation Classes throughout the year. It is important for the expectant parents/guardians to arrange to attend a session **5 months before the birth and Baptism** of the child. Contact the parish offices for more information. **The next class is scheduled for Saturday, January 21, 2017, from 9:30 to 11:00 AM.**

Funerals: To be arranged with a priest and funeral director.

Sacrament of the Sick: Anytime

Marriage: Arrangements should be made one year in advance and prior to making reception plans.

Notre Dame de la Mer Baptism Changes

Beginning this month, October 2016 Baptism will be celebrated after the 10:30 a.m. Mass on the Fourth Sunday of each month. In the months of March, June, September and December each year Baptism will also be celebrated during the 10:30 a.m. Mass on the Second Sunday of the month. In December of 2016 there will be **no baptisms** after the 10:30 a.m. Mass on the Fourth Sunday due to the fact that the Fourth Sunday is Christmas Day. Please check the parish website for a list of the baptism dates for the next year.

It is also suggested that if you will be celebrating the sacrament of Baptism in the near future and need to attend a baptismal preparation class that you look ahead and attend the class before your child is born. In the same way that you prepare for the birth of your child with clothing and furniture and a new room you need to prepare for your child in the faith by attending the baptismal preparation class and selecting appropriate godparents who can help you with your child's growth in the faith. 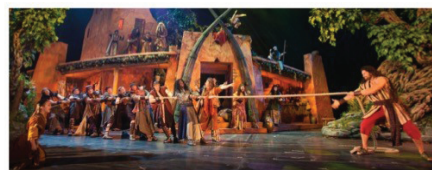
