Letter From Sister Rosaline Walters

Dear Friends,

How many of us have experienced a Zacchaeus moment in our lives? A time when we have been caught speechless by a particular person or event (surprise). The Gospel today has two of my most favorite characters portrayed. The first, of course, is Jesus and the second Zacchaeus.

In today's gospel, Jesus surprises Zacchaeus by inviting himself to Zacchaeus' house for dinner. Saint Luke describes Zacchaeus as being a tax collector and short in stature. Zacchaeus, being short and wanting very much to see Jesus as he passed along the way to the city of Jericho. The path was lined with many people. Since Zacchaeus was so short, he decided to climb a sycamore (fig) tree in order to catch a glimpse of this man who raised Lazarus from the dead and restored sight to the blind man, Bartimaus. As Jesus reached the tree where Zacchaeus was perched, he looked up, saw him, and told him to "hurry down" because he had to stay at his house. As the crowd began to witness Jesus' actions they began to talk among themselves. The name Zacchaeus means "clean", but in the eyes of the town's people Zacchaeus was not clean. According to Jewish Law, Zacchaeus was classified as a sinner. He was rejected by his own people because he was a tax collector for the Romans and not one of the law abiding townspeople.

As Jesus neared the sycamore tree, where Zacchaeus had perched, he looked up and saw Zacchaeus, and called him by name. We might assume that they had met before, or that Jesus may have known him because of his work as tax collector – no matter what the reason – it was an opportunity for Jesus to teach us that we should reach out to all and embrace them. We know that Jesus came to seek out and save the lost. Zacchaeus, in answer to Jesus' call, pledged half his possessions to the poor and promised to repay anyone he defrauded, four times the amount.

Could we be like Zacchaeus and look at our own status? Do we consider the common good? And do we extend ourselves outside our comfort zone? Each time we receive Communion, we are inviting Jesus into our house. Have we allowed him to change us?


