### From the desk of Frank Stone, Lazarus House Director

Dear Parishioners,

Jesus said; "For I was hungry and you gave me food..."

This famous quote is an intricate part of the mast head and logo of Lazarus House Emergency Food Pantry. As we approach Thanksgiving, Christmas, and winter, at Lazarus House we enter the "season of worry". Will we have sufficient food donations to distribute to those in need? Will we have the financial resources to keep the pantry shelves full of basic food essentials and personal care items that are necessary for fundamental day to day living?

According to a recent report from the US Department of Agriculture, 74 million homes across America face food insecurity. This is 3 million more than last year.

At Lazarus House we are keenly aware of this statistic, because in our small corner of America, during 2023 Lazarus House provided food and personal care items to over 17,000 individuals, families and children. So far in 2024, we are 28% ahead of that number of guests served.

The past few weekends' volunteers from Lazarus House have distributed brown bags after the Masses to be filled with non-perishable food items to be presented during the offertory procession at the Thanksgiving morning Mass.

Also, as you have seen there are Lazarus House baskets in both of our churches where food donations can be placed at any time. Hunger never takes a holiday.

We are tremendously grateful for the ongoing support of our community. Quite frankly, we couldn't do it without you. If you would like to know more about Lazarus House, our brochures are in the information displays in both churches, or even better, stop by the pantry any Monday, Wednesday or Friday between 10:00 AM and 12 noon to see in person our 75 volunteers, welcoming those in need, sharing hospitality and encouragement to the guests we serve.

# Readings of the Week

#### Reading I: Daniel 7:13-14

The Son of Man will come on a cloud.

- The reading from Daniel is part of a vision of the victory of God's kingdom over all human kingdoms.
- The kingdom of God appears as a human who comes from heaven, God's domain.
- God presents everlasting kingdom, power and glory to the human ("son of man").

#### Reading II: Revelation 1:5-8

Jesus is the faithful witness.

- The Book of Revelation, written during the Roman persecution at the end of the first century, looks forward to the return of Jesus and the establishment of God's kingdom.
- The reading portrays Jesus as the Son of Man, the witness to the truth of resurrection and the hope for everlasting life.
- Jesus is the victor over all earthly rulers and has made God's people into a royal nation, a nation of priests.

#### Gospel: John 18:33b-37

My kingdom does not belong to this world.

- The Gospel of John presents Christ the King in a different light.
- During his lifetime Jesus bears the title of ruler only at his most vulnerable moments.
- Jesus rejects the title, "King of the Jews," that Pilate gave to him because his kingdom is not of this world, he is the Messiah sent from heaven.

### Saint of the Week:

#### St. Gertrude the Great, Religious

Gertrude was born on January 6, 1256, at or near Eisleben, Germany, and she entered the Benedictine Convent of Helfta at the age of five. There, she came under the care and influence of the abbess, also named Gertrude, and her sister, Mechtilde. Under the guardianship of these two saints, Gertrude soon learned to speak and read Latin and developed a liking for the study of philosophy from the texts in that language. In about 1282, Gertrude experienced the first of a series of visions of Christ which would continue for the remainder of her life. Gertrude began to write of her visions and these writings spread throughout Europe where her reputation as a theologian developed and grew over the next several centuries.

While this saint was especially learned, it was not until she was about twenty-six that she chose the field and ministry that was to lead to sainthood.

This is now celebrated in the United States as an optional memorial on **November 16.**


