Letter From AnnaMae Muryasz

Dear Parishioners,

May the Lord strengthen your hearts that you may do well in working for Him! Paul prayed these words in today's second reading so that his followers would continue to do the good that they had begun for the Lord. This too, is the prayer we pray for each other today that the good that has begun in each of us may continue to grow and increase for the Lord Jesus.

As we begin to watch the colors of leaves change we also realize the lives of those around us change. The second grade children will be presented to the parish next weekend one month prior to receiving the sacrament of Reconciliation for the first time. They will be presented at the 8:30 a.m. mass at Assumption Church and First Reconciliation will take place at St. Ann Church on Tuesday, December 13, 2016 at 6:30 p.m. All families and family members of the children are invited to be present and to receive the sacrament of Reconciliation after the children that evening if they so desire.

The year of Mercy will shortly be coming to a close but our personal acts of Mercy will continue on. Our acts of Mercy are life-long acts of Love done for the Lord. On Sunday, November 20, 2016 at the rear doors of the churches there will be baskets with small shiny stones that have a cross on them. Please take one of these shiny stones as a reminder to continue to perform acts of mercy even though the year of mercy is complete.

The gospel today is a bit confusing and yet it does indeed have a purpose. The people of the time wanted to know about an afterlife and wanted to see how Jesus would respond to the question. We hear Jesus respond that God is the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, but not God of the dead. God is God of the living, for to him all are alive....God is a perpetual spring of life. Death does not destroy our union with God. God is the God of the living because for God all are alive. It is for this stronger union with God that we look to the afterlife and to our future with God in heaven.

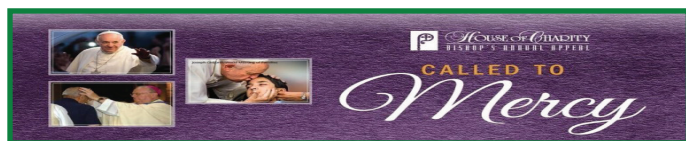

Sacraments

Pre-Baptismal Classes: As the primary educators of their child, the parents/guardians and godparents have the most important influence on the faith development of children and parishes must provide catechesis for them before their child is baptized. Notre Dame de la Mer Parish offers six Baptism Preparation Classes throughout the year. It is important for the expectant parents/guardians to arrange to attend a session **5 months before the birth and Baptism** of the child. Contact the parish offices for more information. **The next class is scheduled for Saturday, January 21, 2017, from 9:30 to 11:00 AM.**

Funerals: To be arranged with a priest and funeral director.

Sacrament of the Sick: Anytime

Marriage: Arrangements should be made one year in advance and prior to making reception plans.

Notre Dame de la Mer Baptism Changes

Baptism is celebrated after the 10:30 a.m. Mass on the Fourth Sunday of each month. In the months of March, June, September and December each year Baptism will also be celebrated during the 10:30 a.m. Mass on the Second Sunday of the month. In December of 2016 there will be **no baptisms** after the 10:30 a.m. Mass on the Fourth Sunday due to the fact that the Fourth Sunday is Christmas Day. Please check the parish website for a list of the baptism dates for next year.

It is also suggested that if you will be celebrating the sacrament of Baptism in the near future and need to attend a baptismal preparation class that you look ahead and attend the class before your child is born. In the same way that you prepare for the birth of your child with clothing and furniture and a new room you need to prepare for your child in the faith by attending the baptismal preparation class and selecting appropriate godparents who can help you with your child's growth in the faith. 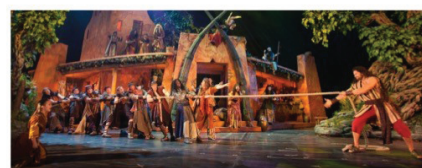

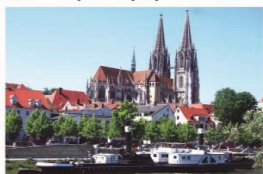
