From the desk of Kevin Quinn, Parish Administrator

Dear Friend,

Usually, Advent sneaks up on me. And due to the late Thanksgiving holiday, it has once again! It is hard for me to fathom as I sit here during the last week of November, still pondering the things I am grateful for, I am writing this letter to you for the bulletin of Dec.08, the Second Sunday of Advent. It is with those thoughts of gratefulness and preparation that remind me of what lies ahead during the next few weeks.

I do love Advent. I love the themes of hope and peace, love and joy; expectation and preparation. The changing of the Church seasons always allows space for reflection and a reset of the spiritual life if we happen to be in a rut. This year in particular, entering into the Advent season with hope and peace on our minds and in our hearts, it is fitting to have hope and peace at the forefront of our thoughts as we navigate our nation's political landscape and the global geopolitical landscape as well.

As you are keenly aware, the news is filled with stories of war, violence, greed, political theatre, racial tension, and environmental calamity. In my conversations with my children, I realized that they feel they're inheriting a world filled with problems that cannot easily be solved. I can only encourage them to see beyond what is and what has been, heed the negatives as warnings to change, and imagine a future that is not defined by the past. As they are beginning their college careers, I remind them what they must do! They must have HOPE. They must strive for PEACE. They must remain JOYFUL. They must LOVE. Additionally, they must become part of the solution by using the traditional values instilled in them by our family and our parish / school community. There is an opportunity for them, and all of us for that matter, to lead and become a light.

Our faith tells us that solutions are very rarely what we imagine them to be. Advent is about hoping for the fulfillment of a promise, without understanding what that fulfillment will be. Advent is a season of the impossible becoming reality.

The word 'advent' comes from Latin and means 'coming' or 'arrival' and points to our celebration of Christ's first coming as a child and our celebration of his expected second coming. Remembering His coming draws us outside of ourselves, it draws us out of the difficult circumstances in which we are tempted to wallow. The liturgy of the Advent season prepares the faithful for Christmas through the change of vestments and the beautiful readings and liturgies that point to Christ's coming.

There is a yearning that accompanies the human heart during this time of year. Personally, I am yearning for the hope that comes with the advent season. I yearn for the feelings that exist when hope is placed in Jesus. And I also pray for peace...peace in my heart and peace on the earth! What are you yearning for this Advent? More importantly, what are you praying for this Advent?

Reading I: Baruch 5:1-9

God will show all the earth the splendor of Jerusalem.

- The passage from Baruch borrows the prophetic language of Second Isaiah which presents a glorious vision of the vindication of God's people.
- Jerusalem, clothed in the glory and justice of God, would welcome her children home.
- All creation would share in the delight and make a smooth shady path for the people of God.

Reading II: Philippians 1:4-6, 8-11

He who has begun a great work in you will continue to strengthen you.

- Paul's Letter to the Philippians expresses his great hope for the people in Philippi whom had enthusiastically accepted the Gospel of Christ.
- The Philippians had supported Paul financially and shown kindness to him during his imprisonment.
- Paul reminds them to love one another and to value what truly matters.

Gospel: Luke 3:1-6

The preaching of John the Baptist.

- In today's Gospel, Luke sets the story of Jesus in historic context for his Gentile audience by listing the important figures of the time.
- At the end of the list, he concentrates on John the Baptizer.
- The lone prophet, John the Baptist, was to preach the arrival of God's salvation in Jesus.

Saint of the Week:

Ambrose, Bishop and Doctor, c. 340-397

Ambrose was a brilliant lawyer and while speaking to an assembly at a church while they were selecting a bishop, was nominated for bishop himself. He had never been baptized, but when he did decide to become baptized, was elected bishop one week later. He began studying Sacred Scripture and the writings of great religious scholars. He spoke against the Arian heresy and had it mostly eliminated from his diocese. Saint Augustine studied with him, was baptized by him, and was a strong supporter. Saint Ambrose was a strong political and religious figure who used his power to fair and just ends.

Feast Day: December 7.

Ambrose's message today: As bishop of Milan, Ambrose held much power, both in his diocese as well as in the empire itself. Yet he was very careful to use the power to fair and just ends. Above all, he followed Scripture and Church teachings as his true guide.


