From the Desk of Kevin Quinn, Parish Administrator

Dear Friend,

Usually, Advent sneaks up on me. And it has once again! It is hard for me to fathom as I sit here during the last week of November, still pondering the things I am grateful for, I am writing this letter to you for the bulletin of Dec. 10, the Second Sunday of Advent. It is with those thoughts of gratefulness and preparation that remind me of what lies ahead during the next few weeks.

I do love Advent. I love the themes of hope and joy; love and peace; expectation and preparation. The changing of the Church seasons always allows space for reflection and a reset of the spiritual life if we happen to be in a rut. This year in particular, entering into the Advent season so far with hope and peace on our minds and in our hearts, is more important than ever during the somewhat dark and challenging times we face.

As you are keenly aware, the news is filled with stories of violence, greed, political strife, racial tension, and environmental calamity. I know many people who are not simply angry because of what is happening in this country, and world for that matter, they are sad because they feel powerless. In my own conversations with my children, they feel that they are inheriting a world filled with problems that cannot easily be solved. I can only encourage them to see beyond what is and what has been, heed the negatives as warnings to change, and imagine a future that is not defined by the past. As they get ready to graduate high school and begin their college careers, over the next two years, I remind them what they must do! They must have HOPE. They must strive for PEACE. They must remain JOYFUL. They must LOVE. Additionally, they must become part of the solution by using the traditional values instilled in them by our family.

Our faith tells us that solutions are very rarely what we imagine them to be. Advent is about hoping for the fulfillment of a promise, without understanding what that fulfillment will be. Advent is a season of the impossible becoming reality.

The word ‘advent’ comes from Latin and means ‘coming’ or ‘arrival’ and points to our celebration of Christ’s first coming as a child and our celebration of his expected second coming. Remembering His coming draws us outside of ourselves, it draws us out of the difficult circumstances in which we are tempted to wallow. The liturgy of the Advent season prepares the faithful for Christmas through the change of vestments and the beautiful readings and liturgies that point to Christ’s coming.

There is a yearning that accompanies the human heart during this time of year. Personally, I am yearning for the hope that comes with the advent season. I yearn for the feelings that exist when hope is placed in Jesus. And I also pray for peace...peace in my heart and peace on the earth! What are you yearning for this Advent? More importantly, what are you praying for this Advent?

Readings of the Week

Reading I: Isaiah 40:1-5, 9-11

Prepare the way of the Lord

- The reading from Isaiah was written at the end of the Babylonian exile.
- The prophet helps the people imagine their return from exile and the restoration of their land.
- Like the Exodus from Egypt, this new exodus from Babylon will reveal to all humankind the glory of the Lord

Reading II: : 2 Peter 3:8-14

Be holy in your conduct and devotion.

- Many of the early Christian communities believed that Christ would return soon after his Resurrection.
- The author of 2 Peter gives a stern warning to those who have given up on the return of Christ.
- God does not work in human time.

Gospel: Mark 1:1-8

I send my messenger before you.

- Mark's Gospel begins the story of Jesus by introducing John the Baptist, describing him with phrases from Isaiah (40:3), Malachi (3:1), and Exodus (23:20).
- John is also portrayed as Elijah, the great northern prophet of the ninth century B.C., who called Israel back to fidelity to Yahweh.
- Pictured with images of every precursor of exodus and deliverance, John preaches a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins.

- This Sunday's readings call for change. What changes do you need to make in your life in order to celebrate the true meaning of Christmas?
- Talk about how your Christmas giving reflects God's care for creation, for the poor, for others. Support organizations that help impoverished families worldwide become more self-reliant, such as Heifer International and the Fair Trade Federation.
- As a family discuss ways to prepare for God's coming. Plan some way to bring God's love at Christmas to someone who is less fortunate than your family.
- Letter the words "Prepare the Way" on a sheet of poster-board. List on the paper ways your family can prepare for the coming of Christ. Talk about ways to prepare room in your life for God.




