Letter From Father Yvans Jazon

Dear Parishioner,

Prepare the way of the Lord!

My brothers and sisters, Christmas is around the corner. Again, we are preparing ourselves to celebrate the birthday of our Savior, Jesus Christ. As Catholics, we know this time always brings excitement in our faith and in our family. Often family is preparing to travel to meet other family members. The feast of Christmas gives us an opportunity to bring Christ to others. As we are preparing ourselves for His second coming, the gospel for this third Sunday of Advent helps us to experience a great man who was sent by God to prepare the way of Christ. He was not the Light, but he came to testify to the Light. Like John the Baptist, we are all called to be a testimony for Christ in the World. In so many aspects we represent Christ in our neighborhood and in our family. Like John the Baptist in the Gospel, when we are conscious of the presence of the Lord in our lives, then we can be witnesses for God's light while steadfastly denying that we are the light. The more we create space for God's grace and blessing, the more we become a "voice crying in the wilderness: Make straight the way of the Lord".

This third Sunday is Gaudete Sunday, where we will light the Candle of Joy, this Isaiah excerpt fits very well in the context of Advent as it is a message of hope and joy for all of us. It is an announcement of salvation for those who are suffering either from a sickness, or either from social displacement, or from feeling sad, or from grieving from the loss of a love one. We are invited to rejoice in the Lord. We anticipate the coming of Christ not with fear but with Joy. In the first reading prophet Isaiah announces His coming and the joy His presence will bring to our lives. Through the sacrament that we received, we believe that the Spirit of Lord is upon us, we are his anointed ones, and we are sent to set other people free through our faith and prayer, helping them to experience the compassionate heart of Jesus. The message of all readings this weekend is a message of joy. Yes, God has clothed us with a robe of Salvation. There are so many reasons for us to be joyful, which is a duty of all Christians to be happy because Happiness is the fruit of the experience of God's grace.

In the past, Advent only prepared us for Christmas. We now have so much fun before Christmas, if we do not pay much attention it will become more and more diminishing on the proper way to prepare ourselves to celebrate this important feast. We must **not** allow ourselves to be distracted by the way the world wants to make it, but we need to remain faithful to our faith. That's why the figure of John the Baptist, the precursor, can help us to turn our eyes to the one who comes. It is difficult for us to wait and prepare which is why the scripture is teaching us to learn from John the Baptist who is our precursor.

I wish you all a blessed Advent and Christmas Season. May the Lord who freed the Captives, and gave glad tidings to the poor, bless you and your family.




