

<u>What is it?</u> A program from the Augustinian Institute that explains the Catholic Faith in a stunning video series. This series is filmed on location in Rome, the Holy Land, Calcutta and the studios of the Institute. The beauty of Catholism is presented by nationally-known teachers who clearly present the beauty and brilliance of the faith.
