Dear parishioners,

The Finding in the Temple is a very human story, one in which we find Mary and Joseph acting exactly like parents would --- filled with anxiety and scrambling to find their son. We would do the same. Yet, the highlight of the story isn't necessarily the "finding" of Jesus. Rather, it's what we see Jesus doing . speaking...communicating with those he loves.

Truth be told, Mary and Joseph, were not prepared to see their son in quite the same way that we do today. But they knew he was special, knew that he was in a sense a "miracle" of sorts, knew that he wasn't exactly the same as every other young man or woman. But beyond that, it probably still was all a bit confusing to them. After all, they didn't even realize what he meant by his "Father's house".

Yet, it was so fitting for them to see him in this way, speaking and teaching and inspiring. You see, both Mary and Joseph were the kinds of people who believed that God was still communicating with his sons and daughters, still speaking to people who had ears to hear, still encouraging and inspiring and challenging all who would listen. That's the kind of faithful people they were.

And so, when the angel Gabriel comes to Mary --- she is ready, ready to hear what God has to say. And when an angel of the Lord comes to Joseph in a dream --- he is ready, ready to hear what God has to say. And the world would never be the same.

Are we as ready as they were? Do we truly believe that our loving God is still speaking to us, still communicating to each of us in this time and place --- in the silence of our hearts, through Sacred Scripture, in the teachings of the Church, through the beauty of his creation, and even through the people around us--- people of good will who are trying to help us be more, give more, and love more?

My friends, despite our best intentions, we too can "lose" Jesus. Often without realizing it, we wander away from the Jesus of the Gospels; we suddenly discover that the focus of our lives is not the compassion and generosity and peace of Jesus.

So let today's Gospel be a "gut check" for each of us: a time to "find" Jesus again within the love of family and friends, to "rebuild" our homes and hearts into a fitting "temple" of service and generosity for Emmanuel to dwell.

Jesus remains with us even when he seems most distant and farthest away, when we think we have "lost him."

In the gift of the New Year before us, may we resolve not to lose sight of Jesus or our grasp of his hand.

May God our Father give you Grace and peace!

Feast of the Holy Family

The Holy Family is the name given to the family unit of Jesus, His mother Mary and His foster-father Joseph. The main purpose of the Feast is to use the Holy Family as a model for all families. Our homes and families become the “domestic Church” as we live the life of the Church within our homes. We can make Christ and the Church the center of family life by praying together, reading Scripture, attending Mass and trying to imitate the lives of the Holy Family.

Saint John Chrysostom suggested that all Christians homes be a “family church”. Devotion to the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph began largely in the seventeenth century with Pope Pius IX and Pope Leo XIII. They approved general confraternities to help promote the devotion and in 1893, Pope Leo approved the feast and wrote part of the Office.

Pope Leo XIII stated, “Nothing truly can be more salutary or efficacious for Christian families to mediate upon than the example of this Holy family, which embraces the perfection and completeness of all domestic virtues”

Prayer To The Holy Family

“Lord Jesus Christ, who, being made subject to Mary and Joseph, did consecrate domestic life by Your unspeakable virtues; grant that we, with the assistance of both, may be taught by the example of Your Holy Family and may attain to its everlasting fellowship. Who lives and reigns, world without end. Amen.”

Weekly Readings Reflection

Choose one of the following activities as a way to further reflect on the Sunday readings.
