From the desk of Deacon Jim Hallman, Pastoral Associate

Dear Parishioner,

There was a time when my grandmother was in a nursing home and her mind was swiftly deteriorating. Her long and short memory were disappearing, and one day when my grandfather walked in and hugged her, she asked, “*who are you?*” As pitiful as it was to see my grandmother in this condition, my heart went out to my grandfather who for the first time realized he just lost his wife of sixty-five years.

When Jesus says, “*I do not know where you are from,*” He is insinuating ‘I do not know you, because you do not know me.’ But as devastating as those words may be, the most frightening words we could ever hear from Him are, “*Depart from me.*”

Yes, we see many today who casually know Christ and believe that is sufficient, but God knows their innermost thoughts. No person can ultimately deceive the God who sees the heart. It is best said in the Book of Proverbs: “*There are those who are pure in their own eyes but are not cleansed of their filth.*” And for that very reason, Jesus says, “*Not everyone who says, ‘Lord, Lord,’ will enter into the Kingdom of God.*”

Jesus emphatically tells us that heaven is “*Only for those who do the will of My Father.*” The Will of God is following His commandments and the greatest of those commandments is to “*love the Lord your God with your whole heart, your soul and your whole mind.*” God’s Will is doing what is right in God’s eyes. And many times, it requires sacrifice, as Jesus tells us, “*to take up your cross and follow me.*” His Word is the only way; His Word is the only truth, and that way and that truth are the only things that will bring us to eternal life. Jesus died and opened the gates of heaven for all, but not all accept that gift. Some remain distant from God and His teachings.

There was inscribed on the tombstone of a Mount Everest hiker who lost his life on the climb, simply, “*he died climbing.*” Life, for all of us, must be an upward and onward way, pushing ourselves to the peak which we will only accomplish when we cross the finish line. Our house in heaven will be built with the materials we send up to the Builder. And if we have no material for the Builder, He will say, “*depart from me, I do not know you.*” But there will be wailing and grinding of teeth by those departed who see their house in hell made of the materials they sent the devil.

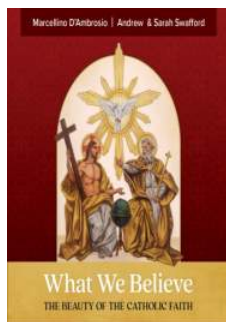

ST. TERESA OF AVILA, THE BOOK OF HER LIFE (AUTOBIOGRAPHY)

Saint of the Week

Maximilian Kolbe, Priest and Martyr 1894-1941

Maximilian Kolbe was the prior of the largest friary in the world located in a village near Warsaw in Poland. When Poland fell to Hitler's Germany in September 1939, the friary was taken over by the Nazis and turned into a deportation camp for refugees, political prisoners and Jews. Fr. Kolbe and a few priests decided to remain at the friary to minister to the sick and prisoners. The priests were expected to preach what the Nazis told them to and to keep the people submissive.

Fr. Kolbe was arrested in February 1941, found guilty of writing unapproved materials, and sentenced to the infamous Auschwitz concentration camp. There, he was assigned to a labor detail. On one occasion, Fr. Kolbe collapsed under a heavy load. He was kicked and beaten by the guards, then shoved into a ditch and left for dead. Another prisoner managed to get him medical care and Fr. Kolbe miraculously survived and regained his strength. He was then assigned to a different barracks and work detail. As before, he ministered as he could to the prisoners, offering encouragement and sharing his small rations of food.

In Auschwitz, prisoners who tried to escape, if caught, were subjected to a slow and agonizing death as a lesson to others. If an escape attempt was successful, the Nazis would select several barracks mates of the escaped prisoner to die instead. When there was a successful escape from Fr. Kolbe's barracks, ten of his fellow prisoners were chosen to be starved to death. One of these cried out, "*My poor wife! My poor children! What are they to do?*" Hearing this, Fr. Kolbe stepped up to the camp commandant and offered to die in the man's place. The Nazi officer accepted his offer.

Fr. Kolbe was marched off with the other prisoners to a windowless bunker where food and water were cut off. Normally, those assigned to die in this manner would be heard throughout the camp crying in despair and attacking one another. But this time, there was singing heard from the bunker ~ Fr. Kolbe was leading his flock to Jesus.

He was the last of the prisoners to die. On August 14, 1941, when the Nazis needed the bunker for another batch of prisoners, a doctor and several German soldiers entered the bunker. Fr. Kolbe, barely alive, was sitting against a wall with a smile on his face, as if seeing some distant beautiful vision. The doctor injected him with a poison and, in a moment, Fr. Kolbe was dead, still with a smile on his face. St. Maximilian Kolbe was canonized on October 10, 1982. His memorial is celebrated on the date of his death, August 14.
