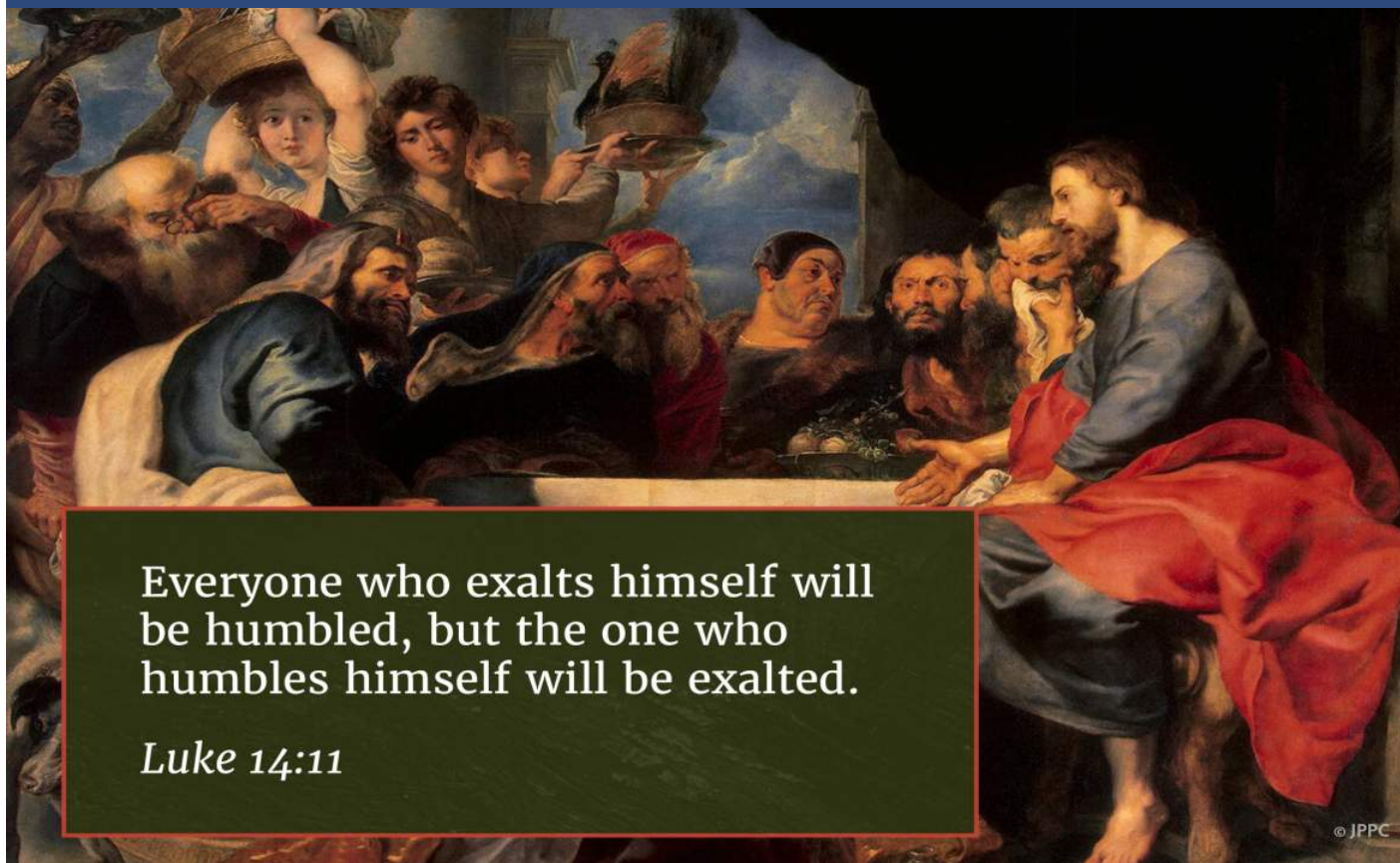

Reflections on the Readings

READING I: Sirach 3:17-18, 20, 28-29 — Conduct your affairs with humility.

♦ Today's first reading gives us the wisdom of Ben Sira, a second-century Jerusalem sage. Because of the upper-class situation of the sage and his students, today's lesson on humility is dramatic. The final verses introduce a favorite subject of Ben Sira: the giving of alms.

READING II: Hebrews 12:18-19, 22-24a — You have drawn near to the city of the living God.

♦ In today's second reading, the image of the Israelites at Mount Sinai is colored with details from the book of Exodus and other Old Testament passages. The gloomy and fearful aspects of the old covenant experience are emphasized in contrast to the picture of Mount Zion. Christians do not have to live in fear of imitating the failures of certain figures in the history of salvation, for they have the advantage of the person of Jesus who sealed the new covenant in His own blood.

GOSPEL: Luke 14:1, 7-14 — Whoever exalts self shall be humbled and whoever humbles self will be exalted.

♦ In today's Gospel, Luke presents a scene with Jesus in the home of a Pharisee. Jesus addresses the guests in the house with a parable that warns against self-exaltation. This lesson comes soon after the disciples were reprimanded by Jesus for vying for position. Jesus' words to the host point out that the kingdom is for everyone, and our hospitality is to embrace all, especially those who are overlooked.

Saint of the Week

Teresa of Avila
Doctor of the Church
1515-1582

Teresa of Avila, sometimes known as Teresa of Jesus, was born in Avila in Castile, Spain. She was one of nine children. Teresa once wrote of her large family, "*all, through the goodness of God, were like our parents in being virtuous, except myself.*"

After attending a convent school, Teresa became a Carmelite nun in 1536. At that time, the convent parlor served as the social center of the town. Many of the townspeople would come to the convent on Sunday afternoons. They and the nuns would sit in the parlor and discuss the issues of the day. Teresa participated in this and enjoyed it for some time, even to the point of giving up much of her prayer and meditation time.

Teresa eventually came to believe that the Carmelite order was too relaxed and began to advocate for reforms. She founded the St. Joseph Convent in Avila and several other convents throughout Spain for nuns who wished to live a cloistered life. These nuns came to be known as the Discalced Carmelites for the sandals they wore (as opposed to the shoes which other nuns wore). With St. John of the Cross, Teresa also founded a Carmelite monastery for men.

In her efforts to effect reform within the Carmelites, Teresa traveled all over Spain and wrote many letters and books which are regarded as classics of spiritual literature. Her book, *Way of Perfection*, was written for the guidance of her nuns and *The Book of Foundations* was written for their encouragement. But Teresa also wrote for the rest of the Church. Her book, *Interior Castle*, explains the contemplative life for the layperson.

Though a contemplative, Teresa managed to successfully blend a highly active life with spiritual meditation. She was a popular person who combined charm and wit with humility and courtesy, so that even her enemies respected her.

St. Teresa of Avila was declared a Doctor of the Church in 1970 by Pope Paul VI, the first woman so honored.

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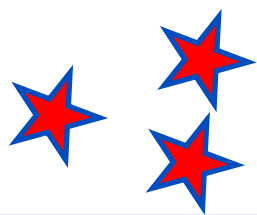
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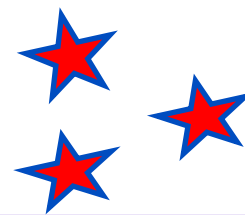

SCHOOL YEAR Family Catechesis:

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION: Preparation to receive First Eucharist, and/or Confirmation requires a two-year commitment to PREP classes as well as classes especially designed to strengthen the understanding of the sacraments. Attendance at Retreats, Service Projects and Parent meetings is also required.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL STUDENTS: All students are required to do six (6) Faith-Filled Events, outside the normal classroom setting, throughout the year.
