Reflections on the Readings

READING I: Wisdom 9:13-18b — How can we know God, unless God gives us wisdom.

♦ The first reading is a set of reflections from Solomon's prayer. The questions do not look for answers; they serve as an act of praise. In today's passage, God's wisdom offers understanding on how to live.

READING II: Philemon 1:9-10, 12-17 — Receive another, not as a slave, but as a very dear brother or sister.

♦ Paul's letter to Philemon provides a good example of how Paul could encourage a member of one of his communities to act in a responsible, Christian way. Treating a slave as a brother was unthinkable in the social context at that time. Paul's short letter to Philemon illustrates living by God's wisdom rather than human wisdom.

GOSPEL: Luke 14:25-33 — Whoever does not renounce possessions cannot be my disciple.

♦ In the New Testament, Jesus is the incarnation of God's wisdom, the teacher who taught humankind to live. Jesus uses examples from human experience to illustrate messages with deeper meanings. In today's Gospel, Jesus uses the example of a wise builder to stress that discipleship is an all-consuming vocation.

Saint of the Week

**Catherine of Alexandria
Martyr
c. 130**

St. Catherine of Alexandria is said to have been born into a patrician family and converted after seeing a vision of Our Lady and the Holy Child.

When the Emperor Maxentius began persecuting Christians, Catherine, only eighteen, went to him and scolded him for his tyranny. Unable to answer her arguments against his gods, the Emperor summoned 50 philosophers to oppose her. The philosophers were converted by Catherine and the infuriated Maxentius had them burned to death.

Maxentius tried bribes to tempt Catherine to give up Christianity, but when these failed, he had her beaten and imprisoned. Upon returning from a trip, the Emperor found that Catherine had converted his wife, one of his officers, and 200 soldiers of the guard. Maxentius had these converts all put to death and sentenced Catherine to die on a spiked wheel. When she was placed on the wheel, her bonds were miraculously loosened and the wheel broke. Catherine was then beheaded.

Since about the tenth century, a great devotion to St. Catherine has existed in the Eastern Church and many churches are named in her honor. St. Catherine is said to have been one of the voices from heaven heard by St. Joan of Arc.

Because of her legendary erudition, St. Catherine of Alexandria is the patroness of philosophers and teachers. An optional Memorial is celebrated in her honor on November 25th.

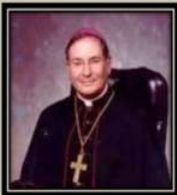

Bishop Arthur J. Serratelli, S.T.D., S.S.L., D.D., Bishop Emeritus of the Diocese of Paterson, New Jersey, is a graduate of Immaculate Conception Seminary School of Theology (ICSST) and was ordained a priest in 1968. He continued his studies at the Pontifical Gregorian University in Rome, earning a doctorate in Sacred Theology in 1977. He returned to ICSST that year and taught Sacred Scripture and Biblical languages until 2002. In 1998, Pope St. John Paul II named Bishop Serratelli a prelate of honor and Auxiliary Bishop of Newark, New Jersey. In 2004, he was appointed Bishop of Paterson, where he served until his retirement in 2020.

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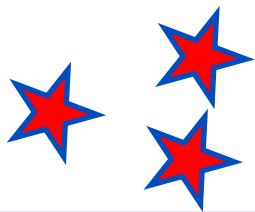
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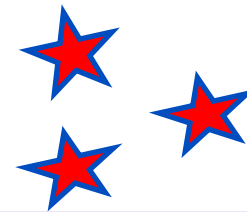

SCHOOL YEAR Family Catechesis:

Classes will be held one Sunday a month.
Parents are to join the children at class and
do assignments at home as a family.
At WCA 9:00AM to 10:10AM

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION: Preparation to receive First Eucharist, and/or Confirmation requires a two-year commitment to PREP classes as well as classes especially designed to strengthen the understanding of the sacraments. Attendance at Retreats, Service Projects and Parent meetings is also required.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL STUDENTS: All students are required to do six (6) Faith-Filled Events, outside the normal classroom setting, throughout the year. This is to help the child understand that faith happens everyday all around you. Not just in class or Mass. Notre Dame de la Mer Parish will host several events that are considered Faith-Filled Events or the family may choose to do events outside our Parish. All these experiences are considered part of the curriculum and failure to comply risks not being promoted to the next level the following year. Registration forms are available at the Parish Office and on the Parish website. Students from other parishes must have their pastor's permission to participate in our program.
