From the Desk of Deacon Rich Roenbeck, Pastoral Associate

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

A servant cannot serve two masters.” (In truth, we know that there are not two masters; we have only one Master.) But why are there some people who, seemingly, live to serve money? Money has no inherent right to be a master of anyone! Sadly, these poor folks choose to be in the thrall of wealth and they themselves assume the yoke of this insidious slavery. They lose sight of the fact that money has no rightful authority but constitutes an **unjust bondage**. That is why Jesus says: *“Make friends for yourselves with deceitful money”* so that by our generosity to the poor we will win the favor of angels and saints.

A pillar of Catholic social teaching is the preferential option for the poor. To quote St. Peter: *“Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God’s grace in its various forms.”*
Peter 4:10

How rightly Jesus spoke of *deceitful wealth*” because, over time, a love of money can be so tempting and seductive that we unwittingly consent to become its slaves. That is why He said: *“If you are not trustworthy with what belongs to another, who will give you what is yours?”* In truth, riches are alien to us because they exist outside of our nature. They are not born with us, they do not follow us in death. But the GOOD NEWS is Jesus belongs to us and we to Him BECAUSE HE IS LIFE AND TRUTH ITSELF. How blessed we are to call Him LORD!

Reflections on the Readings

READING I: Amos 8:4-7 — Don't trample on the needy!

♦ The prophet Amos preached during an era when Israel had forgotten the ways of justice and mercy which were at the heart of the Covenant. At that time, the wealth gap between the merchant class and the poorer rural class had widened. Merchants took advantage of the poor, selling them low-quality merchandise, figuratively enslaving the poor for the price of a pair of sandals. Amos proclaimed that, because the rich had neglected and mistreated the poor, God would come in judgment and destroy the land.

READING II: 1 Timothy 2:1-8 — Pray for all, especially those in authority.

♦ The second reading is the beginning of a long exhortation on “household duties” for the whole church, calling on God’s faithful people to pray for all in need, Christians and non-Christians alike—and also to pray for those in positions of authority to be good leaders. Lifting of the hands with palms open and up is a gesture of prayer used by Jews and Christians.

GOSPEL: Luke 16:1-13 — No one can serve two masters.

♦ Today’s gospel passage is addressed to the disciples of Jesus. It is meant to be a positive message. Landowners in Jesus’ time had agents (stewards) who acted on their behalf. It was common practice for a steward to loan money at a high rate of interest and receive a commission. In the parable, the steward gives up his commission when he has the debtors rewrite the note. Because the steward found a clever solution to his problem, the landowner praises him. All parables tell something about the Kingdom of God. In this parable, Jesus makes an appeal for his followers to be as enterprising in their pursuit of the Kingdom as this steward was in trying to make a place for himself in this world.

ST. THERESA OF LISIEUX, Story of a Soul

Saint of the Week

Gianna Beretta Molla
1922-1962

Gianna was born in Magenta, Italy on October 4, 1922. Raised by devout Catholic parents, Gianna was taught that life is a gift from God and should be used for the good of others. As a young girl, she was active in the St. Vincent de Paul Society, working with the poor. Throughout her life, she was a daily communicant. She enjoyed skiing and hiking in the mountains.

After graduation from university in 1949 with degrees in medicine and surgery, Gianna opened a clinic where she cared for mothers, babies, the elderly and the poor. She offered her time to Catholic Action, took no money from the poor whom she treated, and often gave her poor patients money for medicine and food. Her love of children led her to study at the University of Milan for a specialization in pediatrics in 1952.

Gianna married Pietro Molla in 1955 and, over the next four years, the couple welcomed the birth of three children. Gianna was a loving mother who was able to balance the demands of her career and her growing family.

In September 1961, Gianna, pregnant with her fourth baby, was found to have a uterine tumor. One option was to have a hysterectomy that could correct the problem, but at the cost of the fetus and future children. Another option was to have an abortion, but that was morally offensive to Gianna. The third option, which Gianna chose, was a complex and higher risk operation that would remove the tumor while making every effort to save the baby. She insisted that nothing was to be done to endanger the life of the baby. She wrote, *"I trust in God, yes; but now it is up to me to fulfill my duty as a mother. I renew to the Lord the offer of my life. I am ready for everything, to save my baby."* The operation was successful in removing the tumor without harming the baby. On April 20, 1962, Gianna went to the hospital to give birth. She told her husband, *"If you must decide between me and the child, do not hesitate: choose the child--I insist on it. Save the baby."* On April 21, Gianna gave birth. But she contracted an infection while in the hospital which led to her death a week later on April 28, 1962.

Gianna was beatified by Pope John Paul II on April 24, 1994 and canonized by him on May 16, 2004. Her life is celebrated by a memorial on April 28.
