Reflections on the Readings

READING I: Amos 6:1a, 4-7 — Don't be complacent!

♦ Today's reading from the prophet, Amos, refers to a time of great wealth in the northern kingdom of Israel. The emphasis is on the self-indulgence of the wealthy. Amos rebukes them for their indifference to the needs of others. Because of their disregard for the poor, the wealthy will be the first to go into exile.

READING II: 1 Timothy 6:11-16 — Fight the good fight of faith.

♦ Paul's use of the term "man of God" in reference to Timothy is important because it is a title applied to Moses, a great leader. Timothy's position as a leader demands that he give witness to Christ and seek after virtue, especially those virtues that build up the church. True teaching does not destroy communities and lead to division and arrogance.

GOSPEL: Luke 16:19-31 — Keep your eye on God's way of life.

♦ In the gospel readings prior to today's gospel, the religious leaders had rejected Jesus' teachings about possessions. This parable addresses their attitude. The rich man was oblivious to the needs of the poor beggar, not realizing the seriousness of his complacency. The indifference of the rich man led him to an eternal situation worse than that of Lazarus on earth.

This project has been authorized by the Diocese as Phase II of work urgently needed at St. Ann Church. Phase I has been completed, including repair and improvements to the handicap entrance and installation of new flooring in the vestibule, sacristy, and old chapel.

Saint of the Week

**Wenceslaus
King and Martyr
c. 907-935**

Wenceslaus was born into the royal family of Bohemia (Czech Republic in modern times). He was raised as a Christian by his grandmother, St. Ludmilla. At the time, Christianity was not widespread and most of the nobility class were very much against it.

In 925, Wenceslaus assumed the throne after the death of his father. Wenceslaus proclaimed that he would rule with justice and mercy and intended to honor the law of God. He decreed that oppression of the peasants by the nobility would be met by severe punishment. The nobility raised bitter opposition against him. A group of nobles, including his own brother, plotted against him and were successful in assassinating the good king in 935 while Wenceslaus was on his way to attend Mass.

The Christmas carol, *Good King Wenceslaus*, honors his name and concern for the needy — though there is no historical evidence to support the particular good deed so vividly described in that carol.

St. Wenceslaus is the patron saint of the Czech Republic. An optional memorial on September 28 honors him.

Parish Religious Education Program

Our Parish has a few choices for anyone wishing to receive their sacraments and become Catholic:

Children: 1st-8th graders have two choices:

- ⇒ **School Year Family Catechesis:** Which meets once a month to view lessons completed at home.
- ⇒ **Summer Intensive:** 2nd & 3rd weeks in July Monday-Friday 8:30AM-12:00PM

Teens: 9th-12th graders. Will be decided on an individual basis, depending on the level of instruction needed.

Adults seeking the faith will be entered into the **OCIA** program. **OCIA** usually meets once a week starting in September and going through the Easter Season.
