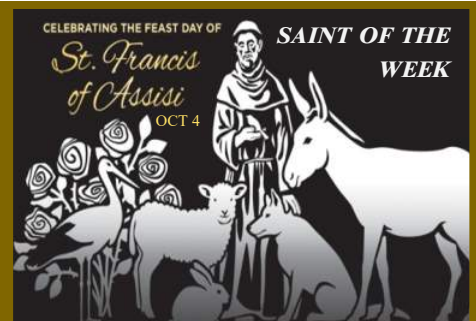

This project has been authorized by the Diocese as Phase II of work urgently needed at St. Ann Church. Phase I has been completed, including repair and improvements to the handicap entrance and installation of new flooring in the vestibule, sacristy, and old chapel.

Reflections on the Readings

READING I: Habakkuk 1:2-3, 2:2-4 — The just one lives by faithfulness.

♦ The prophet Habakkuk preached during a time of great turmoil. He questions why God tolerates violence against the innocent. God told Habakkuk that the faithful person must be patient and wait for God's promises to be fulfilled.

READING II: 2 Timothy 1:6-8, 13-14 — Stir into flame the gift of God.

♦ Paul's letter to Timothy is an exhortation to Christian ministers to be faithful. When one accepts the call to ministry, one is gifted by the Spirit of God. The function of the Holy Spirit is to give strength and perseverance in a difficult job, which is a theme that points to the hardships that must be endured in the ministries of Paul and Timothy and their successors.

GOSPEL: Luke 17:5-10 — Increase our faith; teach us to be humble servants.

♦ The Gospel passage is a collection of Jesus' teachings on discipleship. It begins with Jesus' response to his disciples asking for an increase of faith. Using the dramatic image of a mustard seed, Jesus prods them to reflect on whether they truly possess faith in him. In the parable about the treatment of a servant who has fulfilled his duties, Jesus is teaching his disciples, and us, not to consider our achievements in serving God and one another as means to earn God's love and grace or to deserve a reward or praise from God or others. Instead, Jesus wants our faithful service to be our humble, grateful and loving response to how much and how freely God loves us and blesses us.

Parish Religious Education Program

Our Parish has a few choices for anyone wishing to receive their sacraments and become Catholic:

Children: 1st-8th graders have two choices:

⇒ **School Year Family Catechesis:** Which meets once a month to view lessons completed at home.

⇒ **Summer Intensive:** 2nd & 3rd weeks in July
Monday-Friday 8:30AM-12:00PM

Teens: 9th-12th graders. Will be decided on an individual basis, depending on the level of instruction needed.

Adults seeking the faith will be entered into the **OCIA** program. **OCIA** usually meets once a week starting in September and going through the Easter Season.

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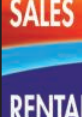
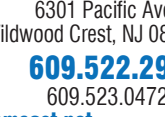
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
