From the Desk of Deacon Jim Hallman, Pastoral Associate

Our Lord doesn't hold back, as He tells us in today's Gospel, the day of His return will be a day of terror.

In the Book of Revelation, we are told, *"Everyone hid in caves and among the rocks of the mountains. They called out to the mountains and rocks, 'Fall on us! Hide us from the face of the one who sits on the throne! Hide us from the anger of the Lamb! The great day of their anger has come. Who can stand before it?'"*

In Isaiah, *"Behold the day of the Lord comes, cruel, with wrath and fierce anger."* And Jesus Himself tells us, *"The Lord will come like a thief in the night."* Frightening Scripture verses, but even more frightening if we are not prepared.

I am sure some of us remember years ago, when we were in school, how we hid under our desks when we heard the air-raid sirens. We called them drills, hiding in case there was an enemy aerial attack of some kind.

Although they were only drills, we were preparing by hiding under our desks to be safe. But when our Lord comes in all His glory, the hiding will be for those unprepared.

In today's Gospel, Jesus is telling us about the awesome sights and the mighty signs that will come from the sky. At the end of the world, when Jesus comes for the final judgment, many will be afraid, many will hide, except those who are prepared.

Many will say, "Where can I hide, where can I flee," but God says, even in darkness I will find you.

No! When Jesus comes, we hope to be the ones who do not hide, for it is a time for praise, a time for joy, a time to welcome Jesus with open arms.

But to be with the chosen ones on the last day, our lamps must be fueled, our soul at peace, always anticipating Jesus' triumphant return.

We live today and tomorrow with Jesus as the center of our every thought, meditating on His infinite and unconditional love for us. Each morning we wake up begins a new drill, preparing us, not by hiding under a desk, but by seeking Him, and loving Him who loved us first. Not by fleeing from God, but by running and shouting, *"Here I am, Lord."* As we read in Malachi, *"For you who fear my name there will arise the sun of justice with its healing rays."*

PHASE II—ST. ANN CHURCH REFURBISHMENT PROJECT



Generous donors are needed to quickly raise \$250,000 to help cover the cost of the removal and replacement of the carpeting in the sanctuary/altar area and main body of St. Ann Church. The existing carpeting was installed in 1987 and the seaside climate and ocean air has taken its toll. The goal is to complete the work by the beginning of Lent.

This project has been authorized by the Diocese as Phase II of work urgently needed at St. Ann Church. Phase I has been completed, including repair and improvements to the handicap entrance and installation of new flooring in the vestibule, sacristy, and old chapel.

Reflections on the Readings

READING I: Malachi 3:19-20a — The sun of justice will arise.

◆ This reading was written during the fifth century B.C. The people had slipped back into complacency. Malachi reminds them that the day of the Lord was coming.

READING II: 2 Thessalonians 3:7-12 — Work is a noble, good thing.

◆ The Thessalonians expected the second coming of Christ to arrive immediately. Some had stopped working and were simply waiting. Paul urges them to imitate him and continue to do what is right..

GOSPEL: Luke 21:5-19 — Your endurance will win you your life.

◆ This gospel passage is Luke's version of Jesus' apocalyptic discourse concerning the end of the world. Two sets of images are interwoven. They include the destruction of Jerusalem in A.D. 70 by the Romans and the coming of the Son of Man at the end of time. By the time the Gospel of Luke was written, it was evident that the return of the Son of Man was not going to happen immediately. Luke encourages Christians to persevere in faithfulness so that they will always be ready.

Saint of the Week

St. Gertrude the Great 1256-1302

When just a child, and perhaps because of the death of her parents, Gertrude was placed in the care of Benedictine nuns in the Monastery of Helfta in Germany. She lived in an era when most women were restricted by custom to narrow cultural lanes. A monastery-sponsored education amidst a self-governing community of religious women was superior to what would have otherwise been available to Gertrude outside the high walls of the cloister. She became well-versed in the humanities, theology and Latin, a language which she showed mastery of in her spiritual writing. She joined the Benedictine order and flourished in religious life.

At the age of 25, Sister Gertrude had a spiritual experience, a vision of Christ, which changed her life dramatically. Before the experience, she was a faithful nun but also interested in secular writers and knowledge for knowledge's sake. After the experience, she immersed herself in Scripture, read widely the writings of the Fathers of the Church, her heart melted under the gaze of Jesus. She completely dedicated her life to Him, with a deep devotion to His Sacred Heart.

Sister Gertrude struggled to convey in words the richness of her continual spiritual experiences. In her visions, Jesus speaks to her almost exclusively at Mass and during the Liturgy of the Hours. A recounting of her visions covers five volumes known, in English, as *The Revelations of Saint Gertrude*. Adjectives, metaphors, and superlatives flow from her pen as she tries to capture the incandescent mystery of what she sees, hears and feels of the intense love of Jesus for humanity as symbolized by His Sacred Heart. In one vision, St. John the Evangelist placed Sister Gertrude close to Christ's wounded side, where she felt His heartbeat. She lived a "nuptial mysticism" in which she was Christ's bride and the Mass was the wedding banquet at which a chaste self-giving consummated the sacred bond.

Sister Gertrude composed her spiritual diaries at the express command of Jesus. Her hymns, prayers, and reflections also show a profound concern for the holy souls in purgatory. She continually begged Christ's mercy on them, and Christ responded that merely petitioning for the release of such souls was sufficient for Him to grant the favor.

St. Gertrude's captivating private mystic revelations became common spiritual reading among the saints of the 16th and 17th centuries and continue to fire the faithful who read them today. St. Gertrude is called "the Great" because of her profound spiritual and theological insights and their lasting impact on Christian spirituality. She was the first woman to receive this title which Pope Benedict XIV bestowed on her in the mid-18th century to distinguish her from other saints with the same first name and to acknowledge her exceptional influence. To date, she is the only female saint with the title, "the Great."

The feast day of St. Gertrude the Great is November 16.

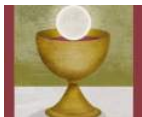

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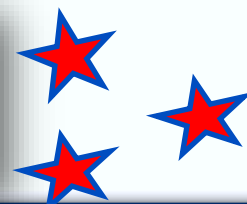
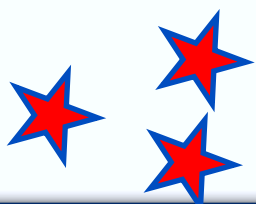

Parish Religious Education Program

PREP

Our Parish has a few choices for anyone wishing to receive their sacraments and become Catholic:

Children: 1st-8th graders have two choices:

⇒ **School Year Family Catechesis:** Which meets once a month to view lessons completed at home.

⇒ **Summer Intensive:** July 20—July 31, 2026

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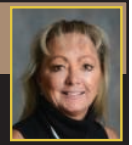


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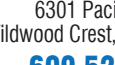
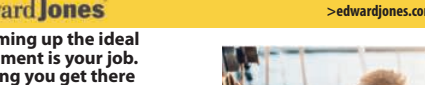
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
