Reflections on the Readings

READING I: Isaiah 2:1-5 — Let us walk in the light of the Lord.

♦ The prophet Isaiah describes a glorious vision of the arrival of God's Kingdom. The event that Isaiah describes, the gathering of people into God's Kingdom and the beating of swords into plowshares, refers to a future time of peace and prosperity, similar to the time of David. This reading urges the people to join in the march toward peace and prosperity by trusting in God.

READING II: Romans 13:11-14 — It is now the hour to wake from your sleep.

♦ With the death and Resurrection of Christ, Paul presents the Christian community with the critical challenge of the present moment. Paul lists six sins to be avoided in preparation for the end time, or indeed for any time in the life of the Christian. Paul urges each person to seek the honorable path and imitate the life of Jesus.

GOSPEL: Matthew 24:37-44 — You must be prepared.

♦ This Gospel reading from Matthew focuses on the second coming of Christ. The images of the two men in the field and the two women grinding meal emphasize the suddenness of Christ's coming and the separation that it will bring. The lesson is: be constantly watchful.

ST. ANN CHURCH REFURBISHMENT PROJECT - PHASE II



Generous donors are needed to quickly raise \$250,000 to help cover the cost of the removal and replacement of the carpeting in the sanctuary/altar area and main body of St. Ann Church. The existing carpeting was installed in 1987 and the seaside climate and ocean air has taken its toll. The goal is to complete the work by the beginning of Lent.

This project has been authorized by the Diocese as Phase II of work urgently needed at St. Ann Church. Phase I has been completed, including repair and improvements to the handicap entrance and installation of new flooring in the vestibule, sacristy, and old chapel.

Saint of the Week

St. Nicholas
c. 3RD-4TH Century

St. Nicholas is the man behind the widely celebrated tradition of Santa Claus, the most well-known Christmas figure after Jesus, Mary, Joseph and the three Kings. Santa Claus' mysterious nocturnal visits to lavish children with gifts at Christmastime is a tradition firmly rooted in Christianity.

Little is known about the life of St. Nicholas other than the fact that he was the Catholic Bishop of Myra in Asia Minor in the early 4th century. It is likely that he suffered during the eight-year cruel persecution of the Church instituted by the Emperor Diocletian. And it is certain that St. Nicholas later attended the Council of Nicea in 325. "Nicholas of Myra of Lycia" appears on one of the earliest and most reliable lists of the bishops at Nicea. Some of those bishops were torture victims and Nicholas could well have been one of them. The bishops gathered at Nicea at the behest of the new Emperor Constantine. As the emperor walked into the hall to inaugurate the great gathering, he stopped and kissed the bishops whose wounds and scars identified them as torture victims of the Diocletian persecution. With this noble gesture, the healing began: the Church was free of governmental persecution. No doubt the bishops were overwhelmed with joy, and Nicholas was among them. The bishops went on to adopt a statement of the orthodox core beliefs of the Church known as the Nicene Creed.

Upon his death, St. Nicholas was buried in his see city of Myra. Less than a century later, a church was built in his honor in Myra and became a pilgrimage site. Historical records tell of the Emperor Justinian, in the 500s, renovating another long-existing church which was dedicated to St. Nicholas. These churches, and hundreds of others named for St. Nicholas, prove that devotion to him was widespread not long after his death.

When Myra was overrun by Muslim Turks in the 1000s, there was a risk that St. Nicholas' bones would be lost. So, in 1897, sailors from Bari, Italy took St. Nicholas' relics to their hometown. In 1089, the Pope came to Bari to dedicate a new church to St. Nicholas. And just a few years later, Bari became the rendezvous point for the First Crusade. St. Nicholas was the patron saint of travelers and sailors, making him popular with the crusading knights. These knights, in turn, later brought the devotion to St. Nicholas they learned in Bari back to their villages dotting the countryside of Central and Western Europe. Thus it happened that a saint famous along the shores of the Mediterranean became, in ways not totally understood, the source of gift-giving traditions that endure until today in every corner of Europe.

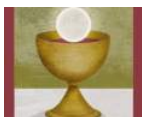

Legends say that St. Nicholas saved three sisters from lives of shame by secretly dropping small sacks of gold through their family's window at night, thus giving each a marriage dowry. Other legends relate that St. Nicholas secretly put coins in shoes that were left out for him. St. Nicholas' legacy of gift-giving became a Central-European and Anglo-Saxon expression of the gift-giving formerly exclusive to the Three Kings. Christmas night gift-giving in Northern lands thus slowly replaced the more biblical-based traditions of giving gifts on the Feast of the Epiphany, a custom more popular in Southern Europe and in lands which inherited its traditions.

The Catholic Church, present throughout the ages of the formation of the cultural "tradition" of Santa Claus, has had a matchless role. Santa wears red for the martyrs. He dons a hat resembling a bishop's mitre. He often holds a sceptre similar to a bishop's crozier. And he distributes gifts to children in humble anonymity on the night of Christ's birth.

Old Saint Nick, Father Christmas, Kris Kringle, or Santa Claus is real in one sense. In all likelihood, he signed the Nicene Creed. Our "Santa" was an orthodox Catholic bishop who worked to establish correct teaching about tenets of the faith. The gift of truth was his most lasting gift.

St. Nicholas is the patron Saint of Russia, sailors, merchants, and children. His feast day is December 6.

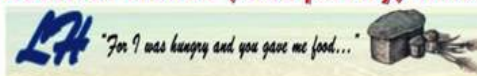

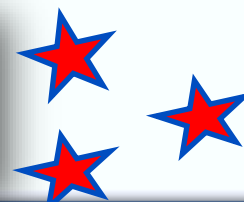
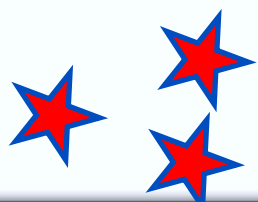

Parish Religious Education Program PREP

Our Parish has a few choices for anyone wishing to receive their sacraments and become Catholic:

Children: 1st-8th graders have two choices:

⇒ **School Year Family Catechesis:** Which meets once a month to view lessons completed at home.

⇒ **Summer Intensive:** July 20—July 31, 2026
Monday-Friday 8:30AM-12:00PM

Teens: 9th-12th graders. Will be decided on an individual basis, depending on the level of instruction needed.

Adults seeking the faith will be entered into the **OCIA** program. **OCIA** usually meets once a week starting in September and going through the Easter Season.

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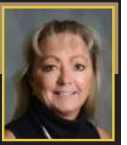


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
