ST. ANN CHURCH REFURBISHMENT PROJECT - PHASE II



Generous donors are needed to quickly raise \$250,000 to help cover the cost of the removal and replacement of the carpeting in the sanctuary/altar area and main body of St. Ann Church. The existing carpeting was installed in 1987 and the seaside climate and ocean air has taken its toll. The goal is to complete the work by the beginning of Lent.

This project has been authorized by the Diocese as Phase II of work urgently needed at St. Ann Church. Phase I has been completed, including repair and improvements to the handicap entrance and installation of new flooring in the vestibule, sacristy, and old chapel.

Reflections on the Readings

READING I: Isaiah 35:1-6a, 10 — The desert will rejoice and bloom!

♦ The prophet Isaiah encourages the Jewish people living in exile in Babylon, to believe that God has the power and the desire to save them. The images in this reading convey new life and hope. This foreshadows what Christians will see in Christ. The prophet's message brings comfort to those in need of liberation.

READING II: James 5:7-10 — Be patient.

♦ The Letter of James urges patience in awaiting the second coming of Christ. Just as the farmer needs to be patient, trust God, and cooperate with the natural elements, so must the Christian. We are called to wait with patience and to hasten the Kingdom through works of mercy.

GOSPEL: Matthew 11:2-11 — The blind recover their sight, cripples walk, lepers are cured, deaf hear.

♦ Today's Gospel describes what kind of Messiah Jesus is. By listing his works of healing and restoration in response to John's question, Jesus shows how he fulfills the prophecies of the Old Testament regarding the Messiah, as suggested in today's first reading. Jesus identifies John as his forerunner.

Saint of the Week

St. Lucy

Late 3rd Century - 304

St. Lucy is one of eight women (including the Virgin Mary) commemorated, by name, in Eucharistic Prayer I of the Mass: "Felicity, Perpetua, Agatha, Lucy, Agnes, Cecilia, Anastasia, and all the Saints..." It was Pope Saint Gregory the Great (590–604), familiar with the Christian traditions of Sicily through his family's roots, who inserted the names of the two Sicilian virgin martyrs, Agatha and Lucy, into the Roman Canon. It is likely that since Lucy was born to Christian parents, she went on pilgrimage as a child to the shrine of St. Agatha, a fellow Sicilian, in nearby Catania. There is a local legend that Agatha appeared to Lucy in a dream, telling her that one day she, Lucy, would be the glory of Syracuse.

There is no doubt that an ancient devotion to a woman named Lucy is connected with the city of Syracuse, Sicily, and that this devotion spread throughout Europe in the fourth through sixth centuries. Though there are enduring legends, tales, and traditions that surround the devotion, no near-contemporary historical records verifying the details of St. Lucy's life or her death have been found. It is the preservation of her name in the Mass, which has secured devotion to St. Lucy in Catholic tradition.

St. Lucy was one of many Christians brutally killed during the Diocletian persecution in the early fourth century. Perhaps the life of and death of the virgin martyr, Agatha, who perished about fifty years prior to Lucy's time, inspired Lucy to be similarly heroic when, as a young woman, her own hour came. Legends which started and endured long after her death tell of how Lucy was doomed to execution after a disgruntled pagan admirer exposed her as a Christian. Later, a gruesome medieval sequel to that tale relates that Lucy had gouged out her own eyes prior to her execution to deter a suitor who delighted in their beauty. Another tradition states that Lucy could not be dragged to her execution site even by a team of oxen, so her executioners piled wood around her – but, try as they might, they could not get it to ignite and, eventually, she was killed by a soldier thrusting his sword into her throat.

St. Lucy is the patron saint of Syracuse, Sicily, Italy. Her feast day is December 13th.

Today is the Third Sunday of Advent, called *Gaudete* Sunday, the Sunday of joy. The joy of the gospel cannot be taken away from us by anyone or anything. The evils of our world--and those of the Church--must not be excuses for diminishing our commitment and our fervor. Let us look upon them as challenges that can help us grow. With the eyes of faith, we can see the light that the Holy Spirit always radiates in the midst of darkness, never forgetting that "where sin increased, grace has abounded all the more" (Romans 5:20).

One of the more serious temptations that stifles boldness and zeal is a defeatism that turns us into querulous and disillusioned pessimists, "sourpusses." While painfully aware of our own frailties, we have to march on without giving in, keeping in mind what the Lord said to St. Paul: "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness" (2 Corinthians 12:9).

Christian triumph is always a cross, yet a cross that is at the same time a victorious banner borne with aggressive tenderness against the assaults of evil. The evil spirit of defeatism is brother to the temptation to separate, before its time, the wheat from the weeds. It is the fruit of an anxious and self-centered lack of trust. — POPE FRANCIS

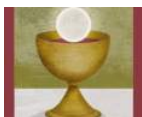

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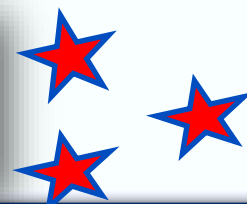
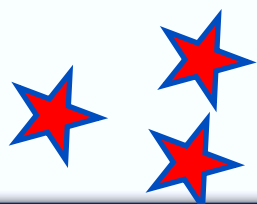

PREP

Our Parish has a few choices for anyone wishing to receive their sacraments and become Catholic:

Children: 1st-8th graders have two choices:

⇒ **School Year Family Catechesis:** Which meets once a month to view lessons completed at home.

⇒ **Summer Intensive:** July 20—July 31, 2026

Teens: 9th-12th graders. Will be decided on an individual basis, depending on the level of instruction needed.

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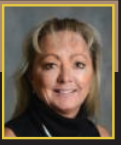


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
