HOLINESS AT HOME

MUSIC AND FAITH

Using music as a tool to help all members of the family learn about God's presence in their lives can be both powerful and deeply moving. Music has a unique way of touching hearts and conveying messages that words alone cannot. Here are several ways you can use music to help family members connect with their spirituality.



HOLIDAY MUSIC

Experience the liturgical Seasons of Christmas, Lent and Advent in a special way by listening to the music of worship during these holy times of preparation. During the Christmas Season, *carols* (versus secular pop Christmas songs) can promote the true meaning of the holiday.



ATTENDING MASS AS A FAMILY

Attend Mass together; bring the children -- Jesus said: "Let the children come to me, and do not prevent them" (Matthew 19:14). At Mass, music plays an important role in connecting with God. Participating to the best of your ability in singing, and hearing the cantor and choir as they minister in song, develops an understanding of the communal aspect of worship and the power of music to unite believers in prayer and praise. Saint Augustine famously said, "To sing is to pray twice."



CHRISTIAN MUSIC AND HYMNS

Listen to a variety of Christian music, including traditional hymns, contemporary Christian music, gospel, and praise and worship songs. These can help members of the family feel connected to a community of faith and understand different aspects of God's nature and love.



CHRISTIAN MUSIC VIDEOS AND BIBLE STORIES

Watch and discuss Christian music videos together. These media offerings can spark meaningful conversations about faith. Find musical adaptations of Bible stories or Christian themes. These can be especially engaging for younger children, helping them remember stories and concepts with catchy songs and melodies.

Integrating music into family life provides family members with a valuable tool for worship, reflection, and expression...music can help each one of them internalize faith and experience God's presence in a profound and personal way.

Reflections on the Readings

READING I: Sirach 3:2-7, 12-14 — Revere your father and bring comfort to your mother.

♦ The command to honor father and mother is the law that Sirach praises in today's reading. The idea of atonement for sin by honoring a parent is a feature new to biblical teaching. Earlier it was taught that atonement is accomplished through sacrifice. Life and family harmony are the rewards promised to those who show respect for both parents.

READING II: Colossians 3:12-21 — Clothe yourselves with mercy.

♦ Paul's theme in this reading is a baptismal one. We are chosen and have put on Christ. The exhortations in his letter are a "household code." Paul urges all family members to relationships that are "in the Lord."

GOSPEL: Matthew 2:13-15, 19-23 — Take the child and his mother and flee to Egypt.

♦ Today's Gospel is part of Matthew's Infancy Narrative. The focus of Matthew's Infancy Narrative is to show that Jesus is the new Moses and the new Israel called out of Egypt. The story of the Holy Family is not only the story of Joseph and Mary and the Boy Jesus. The Church's story of God's redeeming love continues on in the Feast of the Holy Family.



One could read the liturgical prayer "Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to people of good will" not only as a word of praise but also as a kind of formula: when glory is given to God above all things, then peace breaks out among us.

Saints of the Week

St. Basil the Great
329 - 379

St. Gregory Nazianzen
329 - 390

St. Basil the Great and St. Gregory Nazianzen were lifelong friends and fellow scholars, sharing a commitment to Christian virtue and service to the Church. They were both bishops of the early Church and became Doctors of the Church, recognized for their profound eloquence, masterful oratory and extensive writings on fundamental doctrines of the faith. They both played such crucial roles in so many areas of Church life, that they could each be remembered for any number of contributions to liturgy, theology, ecclesiology, Church history, monasticism, and even social services and popular customs, especially in the Orthodox east.

St. Basil founded the "Basiliad," a massive complex in Caesaria that functioned as one of the first hospitals, integrating spiritual and temporal care. He established monastic rules which included the running of such facilities, making them models for organized charitable health care and administration.

During the fourth century, the writings and oratory of St. Basil and St. Gregory contributed to and influenced large gatherings of bishops and theologians who sought to end theological discord and confusion, to settle thorny questions, and to establish an orthodox Christian doctrine. Perhaps their greatest contribution was as theologians who helped define, fundamentally and decisively: what "Trinity" actually means; how Jesus is both fully God and fully man; and how the Holy Spirit is related to God the Father. We can thank them for the statement in the Nicene Creed that the Holy Spirit "proceeds" from the Father and the Son. Today, these words fall easily and familiarly from our lips. But the word, "proceeds," was the fruit of intense thought and prayer, culminating in the theological understanding that truly the Father generated the Son, but the Holy Spirit "proceeds" from them both. It is also thanks to the spiritual insights and expository abilities of Sts. Basil and Gregory, that Catholics recite in the Nicene Creed that the second person of the Trinity is "consubstantial" with the Father. Not equal in origin. Not equal in role. But "consubstantial," or equal in nature. Sts. Basil and Gregory devoted their prodigious God-given talents to enlightening minds to truths of our faith, to removing misguided ideas, and to promoting well-founded theological doctrine to understand God as He understands Himself.

St. Basil and St. Gregory are patron saints of Russia, monks, poets and hospital administrators. The Church celebrates their memorial on January 2.

3:12-17

Brothers and sisters: Put on, as God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, heartfelt compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience, bearing with one another and forgiving one another, if one has a grievance against another; as the Lord has forgiven you, so must you also do. And over all these put on love, that is, the bond of perfection. And let the peace of Christ control your hearts, the peace into which you were also called in one body. And be thankful. Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, as in all wisdom you teach and admonish one another, singing psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs with gratitude in your hearts to God. And whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.

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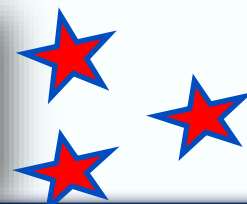
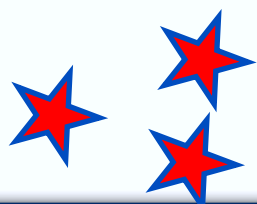

Parish Religious Education Program

PREP

Our Parish has a few choices for anyone wishing to receive their sacraments and become Catholic:

Children: 1st-8th graders have two choices:

⇒ **School Year Family Catechesis:** Which meets once a month to view lessons completed at home.

⇒ **Summer Intensive:** July 20—July 31, 2026
Monday-Friday 8:30AM-12:00PM

Teens: 9th-12th graders. Will be decided on an individual basis, depending on the level of instruction needed.

Adults seeking the faith will be entered into the **OCIA** program. **OCIA** usually meets once a week starting in September and going through the Easter Season.

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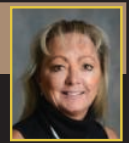


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
