As we accommodate this change and pray for the project to be completed smoothly and efficiently, let us thank God for blessing this Parish and ask the Holy Spirit to "refurbish," as needed, the worship and service we humbly and lovingly offer in both of our beautiful Church buildings.

Reflections on the Readings

READING I: Isaiah 42:1-4, 6-7 — I, the Lord, have called you.

♦ A chosen servant is singled out in this reading, Isaiah's "Servant Song." God's servant is a light to the nations. This reading describes the messiah as God's servant; God's chosen one, who will bring forth justice to all the earth.

READING II: Acts 10:34-38 — God anointed Christ with the Holy Spirit.

♦ Peter's speech comes from the Old Testament: "God shows no partiality" (Deut 10:17) which is applied to God's accepting not only Jews but also Gentiles who act rightly. The reading is a summary of Christian preaching on Christ to Gentiles.

GOSPEL: Matthew 3:13-17 — We must do what God wants.

♦ In the Gospel, Jesus went to John to be baptized in the River Jordan. Jesus' baptism is a prophetic action, a sign for us that God's Kingdom is in our midst. Participating in the rituals of his time, Jesus received through the tradition, a confirmation of his calling as God's Chosen One.

From the Desk of Deacon Jim Hallman, Pastoral Associate

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

I recall sitting on my bunk in Fort Benning, when I was in basic training, listening to a song on my transistor radio. It was the day before my leave to come home for two weeks for Christmas. It was a song called *Crimson and Clover* by Tommy James and the Shondells. Now, reception wasn't great in the barracks, and, as I heard the song, I could hear the words "Christmas is Over," not "Crimson and Clover." It was a sinking feeling, thinking that in a very short time I would be back here in Ft. Benning, with Christmas being over and more training to endure. In that moment on my bunk, life just seemed to fly by. And in reality, it really does. For many of us, as we look back, life is way behind us.

Well, today, as we celebrate the Baptism of our Lord, Christmas truly is over. The Christmas season ends today and tomorrow we move on, back to Ordinary Time in the Church calendar. But let's first enjoy the significance of this day. Today, Jesus begins his ministry, and it is the turning point in his life. Baptisms have a way of doing that. On the day of our own Baptism, we began our journey to eternal life. Jesus is baptized, and when we are baptized, the heavens are torn open, a sign that the barrier between God and man is being removed. Yes, on this day God says to us as well, 'you are my beloved Son, you are my beloved daughter.'

We must never forget that our first duty is always the one imposed by holy Baptism. I tell every parent and Godparent at all the baptisms I do, that the Baptismal promise they make for their children is a solemn promise. A promise made in the presence of the Church, to renounce Satan; a promise so explicit that no one can remove them from it; a promise on which they will be judged at the time of their own death.

Baptism gives us the strength to answer the challenges from this world, not to drift and wander through life, but to identify ourselves as soldiers of Christ. Jesus knew when He saw John that the moment of decision had come for Him. Nazareth was peaceful and home was sweet, but Jesus answered the call from the Father. He heard his Father's voice bestowing his blessing on Him, and the Spirit descended upon Him like a dove. We who are baptized into Christ received this same Spirit, becoming the beloved children of the Father.

Yes, today the Christmas season is over, but before life flies by too quickly, take time today to re-examine what we promised God when we were baptized and also re-affirmed at our Confirmation, and, then live life by those promises. Live in peace, live in love, live for the glory of God. Then, in our hearts Christmas will never be over.

Saint of the Week

St. Anthony of the Desert 251-356

St. Anthony of the Desert may have been forgotten forever, and may have wanted to remain unknown. But St. Athanasius, a famous contemporary of his wrote a short biography of his fellow Egyptian entitled, *The Life of Saint Anthony the Great*. The biography was so widely shared, and so often translated, that it was never lost to history. It has preserved the memory and inspiration of St. Anthony of the Desert down to the present.

The first three centuries of the Church saw persecutions of Christians which at times turned vicious and produced a large number of martyrs. As Christianity was legalized at the start of the fourth century, martyrdom ceased to be the primary form of Christian witness. A new form of radical witness to Christ emerged—the witness of the asceticism of the “Desert Fathers.” These monks retreated into remote places to lead solitary lives of dedication to Christ. Foremost among these Desert Fathers was St. Anthony of the Desert. He was not the first ascetic, but he was perhaps the first to make the radical decision to retreat into the desert.

St. Anthony had money and property as a young man. At the age of 20, after his parents had died, upon hearing at Mass the words of Christ to the rich young man to “go, sell what you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasures in heaven,” he decided to sell his goods, give away his inheritance, and lead the life of a solitary hermit. He removed himself from all temptation except those intrinsic to human nature, he battled the devil, he fasted, he prayed, he worked at manual labor and self-discipline, setting an example for other Desert Fathers and the monastic movement. He became famous for being holy. He emphasized inner silence and self-knowledge as paths to God. He sought Christ alone in every sense—alone in the desert, without family, community, or money. Alone in the world, he clinged to the only person who truly mattered—God himself.

St. Anthony's path of holiness is both radical and refined. It is for few people to walk. But he was the first to walk it so well. He showed that being alone, stripped of all worldly concerns, is a sort of rehearsal for death, where we will meet God alone, every last thread tying us to the world having been cut.

The Church celebrates the memorial of St. Anthony of the Desert on January 17.

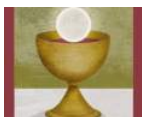

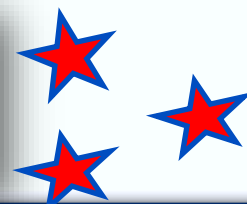
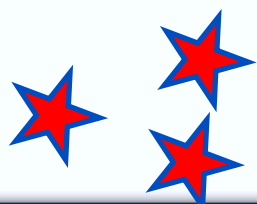
