

Reflections on the Readings

READING I: Sirach 15:15-20 — We have free will to choose good or evil.

◆ The author of the Book of Sirach lived in a cosmopolitan, pagan community that did not support his religious values. He warns that we are responsible for keeping God's commandments regardless of what the prevailing culture may set before us or commands us to do which is contrary to the commandments.

READING II: 1 Corinthians 2:6-10 — Happy are they who follow the Law of the Lord.

◆ God's wisdom is contrasted to the ephemeral wisdom of earthly rulers. God's wisdom is for all ages. "Mature" Christians who love God and witness to God's wisdom can expect blessings beyond all human imagination prepared for them by God.

GOSPEL: Matthew 5:17-37 — The Law is a gift from God and a choice for human beings.

◆ Jesus gave His disciples six examples of how to follow the Law. Four of them are in this Gospel from Matthew. Jesus made it clear that sin begins with the decision to sin, before action is taken. God's Law is a gift to help us live a good life. Following Jesus involves choosing good over evil throughout our life. God's Law is our guide to heaven.

Saint of the Week

St. Josephine Bakhita

c. 1869-1947

St. Josephine was born in the Darfur region of Western Sudan in Africa. Her uncle was a tribal chief. Her family was prosperous and she grew up well-cared-for and happy. When she was around seven years old, she was kidnapped by Arab slave traders, forced to walk 600 miles, and was sold and resold in slave markets over a dozen times over a period of twelve years. The slave traders called her by the Arabic name, Bakhita, "The Fortunate." She eventually forgot her original African name. She was forcibly converted to Islam, suffered cruel treatment by one master after another and was whipped, tattooed, scarred, and beaten.

Her circumstances began to change for the better after she was bought by an Italian diplomat as a maid for his family. There were no chains, no lashes, no threats, no hunger, no beatings. She lived with limited freedom. And she witnessed warm and loving family life. So, when the family was to leave Sudan and return to Italy, she asked and was permitted to accompany them. It had been too long and she had unclear recollections of where to find any of her own family in Africa. Though heartbroken to leave her homeland, she sought to hold on to the position that offered her some degree of kindness and freedom.

After arriving in Italy, she was given away as a gift to another Italian family and became the nanny for the daughter. When the parents went overseas on business for an extended period of time, they sent their daughter and her nanny to stay at the Canossian Sisters' convent in Venice. It was at the convent that the future St. Josephine learned about the Catholic faith, with the sisters answering her many questions. She was so edified by their example of prayer and charity that when the parents returned, she told them she wanted to stay at the convent, discerning a call to follow Christ as a nun. She withstood attempts to persuade her to leave the convent. A court case was brought to try to force her to leave, but ultimately she received a favorable ruling from an Italian court which held that slavery had been outlawed in Sudan before she was born, so she could not have lawfully been made a slave. She was declared absolutely free!

For the first time in her life, she could choose what to do with her life and she chose to remain with the Canossian Sisters and to serve God. She was baptized, confirmed and received her First Holy Communion on January 9, 1890, with the Cardinal Patriarch of Venice, Giuseppe Sarto, the future Pope Saint Pius X, presiding. She took the names, Josephine Margaret and Fortunata. She became a novice with the Canossian Daughters of Charity in 1893 and took her final vows in 1896. Her religious duties included: cooking, sewing, and greeting visitors as the convent's doorkeeper. She also travelled to other communities of her order to share her remarkable story and to prepare sisters for service in Africa. Her humility, sweetness and joy were infectious, and she became well known for her closeness to God.

After heroically enduring a painful illness, she died in Schio, Veneto, Italy with the words, "*Our Lady, Our Lady*" on her lips. St. Josephine was canonized by Pope Saint John Paul II in 2000. Her Memorial is celebrated on February 8. She is the Patron Saint of Sudan and human-trafficking survivors.
