Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

When Jesus sees the grief and mourning of those around Him, including Mary and Martha, He is deeply moved. The shortest verse in the Bible, "Jesus wept," is a powerful expression of Jesus' compassion and empathy for the sorrow of those mourning the death of His friend, Lazarus. Even though Jesus knew that He would raise Lazarus from the dead, His emotional response highlights the humanity of Jesus and His ability to connect with the pain and suffering of those around Him.

Our Lord and Savior knows the power which He is about to exercise (for the glory of God) but He is also deeply moved by the suffering hearts near Him, and the sympathy with human sorrow is no less a part of His nature than the divine strength to which He has access. And that, sisters and brothers, is the awesome nature of Jesus - **He is fully human and fully divine.**

The central thought of today's Gospel is "The Word was made flesh." He is, for us, the Resurrection and the Life, because He has been manifested to us, not as a vague abstraction to be pondered by our intellect only, but as **a person**, living a human life, and knowing its sorrows, Whom the heart can grasp and love.

A "God in tears" has provoked the smile of the theologians and the scorn of the unbelievers. Thankfully, Christianity is not a gospel of self-sufficiency, and its message is not merely to the human intellect. It is salvation for the whole world — for every man, woman and child. The sorrowing heart of humanity has never seen more clearly the divinity of Jesus Christ than when it has seen His glory shining through His human tears.

Reflections on the Readings

READING I: Ezekiel 37:12-14 — I will put my spirit in you.

◆ This reading is part of a longer vision of the movement from death to new life. Ezekiel was preaching to the exiles in Babylon who were convinced that as a people, they were dead. Ezekiel understood that the power of life belonged only to God.

READING II: Romans 8:8-11 — You are in the Spirit.

◆ In this reading, Paul stresses that life in the Spirit is the true life that Jesus came to bring. The death of Jesus led to the gift of everlasting life for those who believe in Him. The Spirit of God, who raised Jesus from the dead, dwells in believers and will also bring their death-bound bodies to life.

GOSPEL: John 11:1-45 — I am the resurrection and the life.

◆ The story of Lazarus is a drama that plays between two understandings of life and death. Jesus announces that He himself is the Resurrection. Lazarus, though raised, will die again. This is different from the Resurrection of Christ. Lazarus rises again to this present earthly life. This miracle is a sign of the greatest miracle of all: resurrection.

Saint of the Week

St. Turibius of Mogrovejo 1538-1606

Turibius of Mogrovejo was a learned scholar of the law who held teaching and other posts in Spain's complex of Church and civil courts. Well-known for his learning, piety, faith, and energy, the Spanish Crown chose him to be the second archbishop of the important colonial city of Lima, Peru. At the time, the arrangement between Spain and the Holy See was that the Spanish Crown chose bishops while the Pope approved, or rejected, them. But Turibius was not a priest. So after the Pope approved the appointment, over the candidate's fierce objections, Turibius received the four minor orders on four successive weeks, was ordained a deacon and then ordained a priest. He said his first Mass when he was over forty years old. About two years later, Turibius was consecrated as archbishop, and then sailed to Lima, arriving in May 1581.

Archbishop Turibius was extraordinarily dedicated to his episcopal responsibilities. He exhausted himself on years-long visits to the parishes of his vast territory, which included present day Peru and beyond. He acquainted himself with the priests and people under his care. He convoked synods (large Church meetings) to standardize sacramental, pastoral, and liturgical practice. He produced an important trilingual catechism in Spanish and two native dialects, learned to preach in these indigenous dialects himself, and encouraged his priests to be able to hear confessions and preach in them as well. His life also providentially intersected with the lives of other saints active in Peru at the same time, including Martin de Porres, Francisco Solano — and Isabel Flores de Oliva, to whom Turibius gave the name Rose when he confirmed her. She was later canonized as Saint Rose of Lima, the first saint born in the New World.

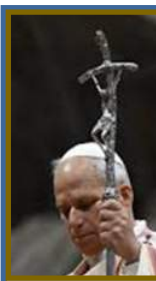
After exhausting himself through dedication to his responsibilities, St. Turibius fell ill on the road and died at age sixty-seven in a town far from home. He had baptized and confirmed half a million souls, had trekked thousands of miles on narrow paths made for goats, had never neglected to say Mass, and did not accept any gifts in return for what he gave. He was canonized in 1726.

There is no tomb of St. Turibius of Mogrovejo in the Cathedral of Lima. There are only fragments of bones in a reliquary. His reputation for holiness was widespread during his lifetime and his relics were widely distributed after his death. In January 2018, Pope Francis prayed before his relics in Lima and invoked his memory in a talk to Peru's bishops. St. Turibius did not, Pope Francis said, shepherd his diocese from behind a desk, but was a "a bishop with shoes worn out by walking, by constant travel, by setting out to preach the Gospel to all: to all places, on all occasions, without hesitation, reluctance, and fear."

St. Turibius of Mogrovejo is the Patron Saint of native people's rights. He was also named the Patron Saint of Latin American bishops by Saint Pope John Paul II in 1983. His Memorial is celebrated on March 23.

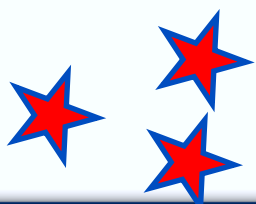

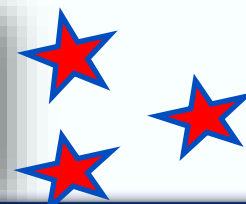

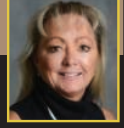
