The 40-day period from Ash Wednesday and before Easter Sunday. It is marked by prayer, fasting, abstinence, and other acts of penance.

WHAT IS FASTING?



One meal a day, and two smaller meals which if added together would not exceed one full meal.

WHAT IS ABSTINENCE?



Abstinence is refraining from eating meat. Meat is considered to be the flesh and organs of mammals and fowl.

Reflections on the Readings

READING—PROCESSION WITH PALMS: Matthew 21:1-11 — This is the prophet Jesus from Nazareth.

◆ The reading focuses on details of the Lord's entrance into Jerusalem and its fulfillment of what had been prophesied.

READING I: Isaiah 50:4-7 — The Lord God is my help.

◆ The reading from Isaiah is part of the third Servant Song. The song communicates the servant's belief that, no matter how cruel or indifferent people are, God's justice will prevail. Suffering is never an end in itself.

READING II: Philippians 2:6-11 — Your attitude must be Christ's.

◆ Paul's letter was written while he was in prison in Rome. Despite being imprisoned, Paul has confidence and joy in Jesus. He stresses that our salvation is in Jesus' emptying Himself — voluntarily relinquishing divine glory, taking human form and becoming a servant, thereby embodying self-sacrificial love and humility.

GOSPEL: Matthew 26:14 - 27:66 — The Passion of our Lord Jesus Christ.

◆ The Passion Narrative is among the earliest traditions to be handed down in written form. In Matthew's Passion account, all the events proceed according to God's will as revealed in the Hebrew Scriptures. Jesus, the servant and Son of God, has poured himself out to overcome humanity's separation from God.

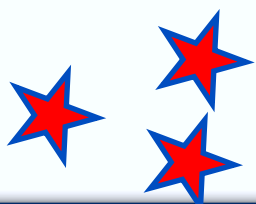

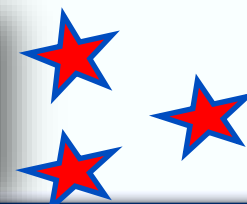

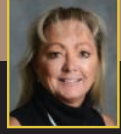
