### FROM REV. ERNEST SOPRANO

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

The Sunday after Easter has been named Divine Mercy Sunday...something it has always been. The Lord chose one of his disciples to be its messenger: Sr. Faustina. [See "St. Faustina's Message" on page 8 of this bulletin.]

Our Gospel today was from an original disciple who was not present when the Lord first appeared after the Resurrection: Thomas! He protests "unless I see and touch, I will not believe." Time passes and Jesus visits a second time and announces, "Put your hand in my side, do not persist in your unbelief, but believe!" This Thomas does! Jesus warns further, "blessed are those who do not see, but believe." Ahah! This is where you and I are included. I'm sure we can recall times when God puts us to the test: the diagnosis that scares us, the child who runs away, the spouse lost in a bottle or handfuls of drugs... "Lord change this and then I will believe."... It is in each of these heartaches that mercy has not been received because it was not asked for. One of the great saints of the Middle Ages, St. Thomas Aquinas explains, "Mercy consists of bringing a thing out from non-being into being." The Apostle Thomas was witness to that when he saw believers devoting themselves to the Apostolic teachings and sharing their goods communally..."in the breaking of bread." These believing people lived for others, generously and selflessly, just as God showed mercy with them.

There was a couple whose child was involved in an accident. Months were spent in trauma units and the ICU. They were told he would never walk again. God's mercy showered upon them when they thanked God that the child was alive! Gradually, the parents were able to see what their child could do and more importantly that he was always "a child of God." Later he came home as did God's mercy. The parents received a further gift...they realized they were to be recipients rather than dispensers of mercy. In all humility they realized they were not in control...but they were loved and that would be enough!

As St. Faustina wrote. " O Soul, whoever you may be, even if your sins were are black as night, do not fear God for great is the power of God's Mercy."

## Reflections on the Readings

### READING I: Acts 2:42-47 — They devoted themselves to a communal life.

◆ A picture of the early Christian community is given in this reading. The Jerusalem Christians met together with joyful hearts. The early Christians lived in the reality of new life in Jesus.

### READING II: 1 Peter 1:3-9— There is cause for rejoicing here.

◆ The First Letter of Peter is a strong witness to the power of faith. The author bursts forth in song, praising God whose gift of faith is our realization of new life, new birth. new life, new birth. We are delivered from death for life in the Lord.

### GOSPEL: John 20:19-31 — “Peace be with you,” He said.

◆ In this Gospel reading, we see more than a Resurrection appearance of Jesus to His disciples; we also see their joy and the transformation of their lives. Because of the new courage that followed from their faith, the disciples move from a state of fear to joy. The second half of the Gospel depicts Thomas' struggle to believe in the Resurrection. The passage challenges Christians to do better, to believe without seeing.

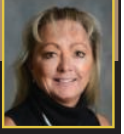
