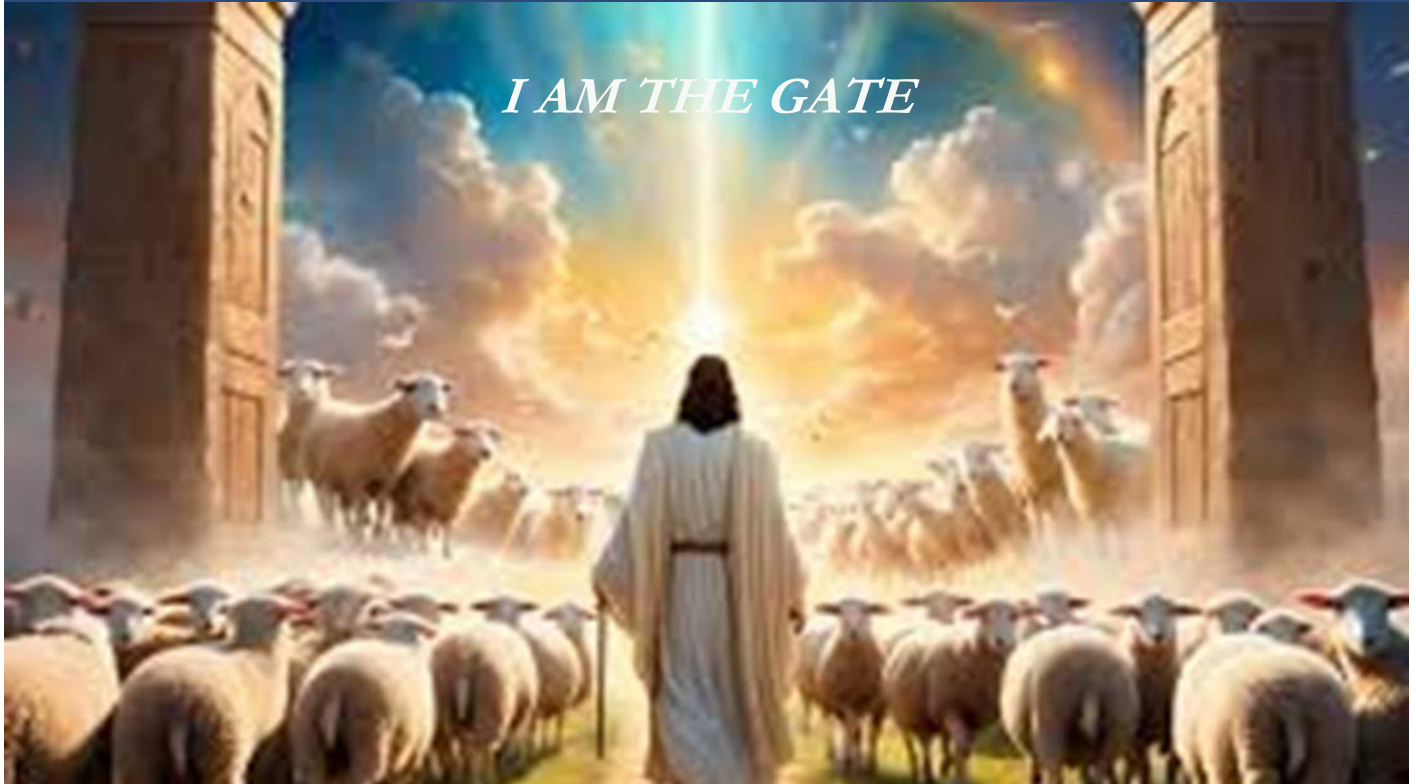

Feast of St. Joseph the Worker ~ May 1



Pope Pius XII instituted the feast of St. Joseph the Worker in 1955 in direct response to the surge of atheistic Communism after World War II. In communist lands, May 1ST, or 'May Day', was "Labor Day." Part of the Catholic Church's response to the Communist appeal to workers was to exalt St. Joseph the Worker on May 1ST as a Catholic alternative to May Day. St. Joseph the Worker was designated as the patron saint of labor. He was the carpenter, the working man, doing his duty of providing his family with food and shelter, and passing on his carpentry skills and work habits to his God-Son.

Work, from a Catholic perspective, is a source of dignity. Work and want and trying times are required ingredients in the recipe for a mature, responsible adult. God the Father worked and God the Son worked. Workers participate in God's own work--subduing the earth is one of God's original commandments to humanity--and subduing the earth cannot come about except through work of one kind or another.

We can make our toil a loving sacrifice to God. If we do it well, we give Him glory; if we do it poorly, we offer Him a shoddy sacrifice. Our good work can be a pathway to holiness, and St. Joseph the Worker is at our side to encourage us as we work for the Lord on our way toward a heavenly home after our earthly labors are done.

Reflections on the Readings

READING I: Acts 2:14a, 36-41 — You must reform and be baptized.

◆ Peter poses some important questions about the meaning of life to the Jews assembled in Jerusalem. From his perspective, those who had yet to recognize that “Jesus was both Lord and Christ” were a corrupt generation. In asking the Jews to believe that Jesus was “Lord and Christ,” Peter was declaring that Jesus is God and Messiah.

READING II: 1 Peter 2:20b-25 — By His wounds you were healed.

◆ The reference to Isaiah’s Suffering Servant points to the example of Christ. Jesus was truly innocent and when he suffered, he did not oppose with force. This message was meaningful for Christians who were suffering persecution at the time for living as followers of Jesus.

GOSPEL: John 10:1-10 — I am the gate.

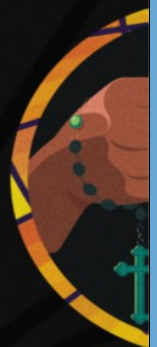
◆ The Gospel portrays Jesus as the gateway to the Church and, ultimately, Heaven. It uses a common image from everyday life at the time of Jesus and it evokes passages from Hebrew Scriptures. In Ezekiel 34, the prophet reveals that God is the shepherd of the sheep. The author of today’s Gospel understands that God has become the shepherd in Jesus.
