Letter From AnnaMae Muryasz

Dear Parishioners,

Welcome to all our new and returning summer parishioners and thank you for your support, help and prayers to all our year round parishioners.

Summer Intensive is the largest undertaking of the Religious Education Department of Notre Dame de la Mer Parish. Registration is now open for the program for students in grades one through eight. Summer visitors who receive a signed pastor permission form from their home pastor may also sign -up for the program. Summer Intensive runs from July 25th to August 5th from 8:30 a.m. to Noon each day. The children are taught the Diocese of Camden Religious Education Curriculum for the year they will enter in school in September of 2016. Please go on the new parish website notre-damedelamer.org and click on Life Long Faith and you will find a registration form for the Program. If you have been in the program before use the returning student form if this is your first time please use the new student form. Payment should be made with the form by mail, in the parish office, by dropping it in the mail slot at the parish office or in the collection basket. Each class closes at 24 in number and two classes already have 12 students in them. Please send the forms in as soon as possible. All paperwork including the pastor permission form must be in for your child to be considered completely registered. Any questions or a desire to help as a teacher or an aide please call me at the office at 609-522-2709 Ext. 218.

They say the future of a parish can be seen by the number of its Baptisms and our numbers are very good. When planning and preparing for the baptism of your child please give sufficient time. Begin your planning and preparation by signing up for a Baptismal Preparation Class **BEFORE** your child is born. This class can be taken five months prior to the birth of your child. The class is held about five times a year on Saturday mornings and due to room space and other considerations only six couples are accepted per class. Taking the class far in advance will allow you the ability to choose the 2nd or 4th Sunday that best fits into your schedule to baptize your child once the wonderful miracle has occurred. The baptism will be celebrated as part of mass on some occasions and on others after the celebration of the mass. The priest that is assigned to the baptisms that Sunday will direct when the baptism will take place. There is no longer a schedule for you to choose during or after mass for your baptism. The Lord is now in charge of this part of the Baptism as he sees fit.

In the heritage of the American family "meals" have always been a favorite place for teachable moments and storytelling. In the Gospel today we hear Jesus sharing a parable about two debtors as He shared a meal at the home of Simon the Pharisee. The parable Jesus uses has a two-fold lesson. The first part of the parable teaches all of us that we are sinners in need of forgiveness and God's salvation. The second part of the parable centers on the sins of the woman. Obviously, her sins were known well by all in the town. Simon the Pharisee considered himself to be better than she was. Yet before God they were both sinners in need of His Almighty forgiveness. Simon welcomed Jesus into his home as he did all his guests but did not go out of his way to prepare for the coming of Jesus. The woman on the other hand washed the feet of Jesus with perfume and dried them with her hair. The actions of the woman showed her willingness to be open to receiving the forgiveness of Jesus because of her great love. Simon on the other hand needed to receive an explanation of the actions taking place. Having great Love and believing in the Lord is a gift from God, a gift we all receive but a gift we need to nurture to allow it to develop and take root in our hearts and in our minds. May we allow our belief in God to take root in our hearts daily and grow so that we may share in the eternal banquet in heaven with the Almighty Father.



Misericordiae Vultus

The Magisterium, the teaching authority of the Church, and we, the people- (each and every one of us) are the Church, the Body of Christ. We are called to be a credible and authentic witness to Jesus Christ and so with this writing our Holy Father Francis makes his final declarations for an extraordinary Jubilee Year. May we accept the countless graces, mercies, blessings and indulgences of this Holy Year of Mercy; may God's love for us touch us in surprising ways; and may we feel the urgent need to act boldly on Pope Francis' fatherly call to be "Merciful like the Father". Pope Francis continues"I present, therefore this Extraordinary Jubilee Year dedicated to living out in our daily lives the mercy which the Father constantly extends to all of us. In this Jubilee Year, let us allow God to surprise us. He never tires of casting open the doors of his heart and of repeating that he loves us and wants to share his love with us. The Church feels the urgent need to proclaim God's mercy. Her life is authentic and credible only when she becomes a convincing herald of mercy, She knows that her primary task, especially at a moment full of great hopes and signs of contradiction, is to introduce everyone to the great mystery of God's mercy by contemplating the face of Christ. The Church is called above all to be a credible witness to mercy, professing it and living it as the core of the revelation of Jesus Christ. From the heart of the Trinity, from the depths of the mystery of God, the great river of mercy wells up and overflows unceasingly. It is a spring that will never run dry, no matter how many people draw from it. Every time someone is in need, he or she can approach it because the mercy of God never ends. The profundity of the mystery surrounding it is as inexhaustible as the richness which springs up from it.

In this Jubilee Year, may the Church echo the word of God that resounds strong and clear as a message and a sign of pardon, strength, aid, and love. May she never tire of extending mercy, and be ever patient in offering compassion and comfort. May the Church become the voice of every man and woman, and repeat confidently without end: 'Be mindful of your mercy, O Lord, and your steadfast love, for they have been from of old' (Ps 25:6)". 
