Dear Parishioners,

Today, in our first reading, we find Elijah ministering to Elisha, but then, Elisha ministered to Elijah who was in need of comfort and encouragement. Elijah called Elisha to a vocation that changed his life forever. This first reading is a forerunner to today's gospel which reminds us that often times the change in relationships causes a change in vocation.

When Elisha sacrificed the oxen and turned his tools into fuel to cook a feast; Elisha proved he was aware that his life had changed completely. From then on, Elisha knew he would no longer tend to his own work; but he would follow Elijah and become a prophet. So...what does this have to do with us? Hopefully, it causes us to ask ourselves exactly what our Christian commitment is asking of us? How are we following God's call? How are we responding to the needs of others?

Today's gospel reminds us that journeys might change and shape us, like the journey with Jesus to Jerusalem changed his disciples. Think about a journey you have taken that changed your life.

Jesus began the end to his life's journey while his disciples were just beginning theirs. Today's gospel also teaches us about the cost of discipleship. Are we following Jesus by working for justice for all, and serving others with mercy? Today, our faith in Jesus calls us to be evangelizers and to profess our Christianity boldly.

Our Christian journey may cost us everything we hold dear. In the Middle Ages, Christians made pilgrimages to holy places to pray. People, today, still do the same. As we read this gospel let us be conscious of how we are imitating Jesus. Do we still have our hand to "the plow"? Are we truly committed to following our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ?

In our second reading, today, Paul reminds us that we were set free from slavery to serve one another in love. Have we allowed ourselves to become free in order to love all as Christ loves us, or have we fallen in to a slavery that allows us to be selfish and refuse to love?

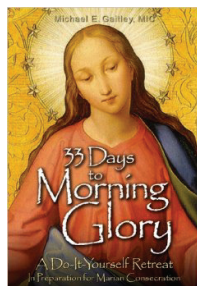

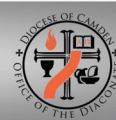
